



South Florida Dynamic Message Sign & CCTV Camera Installation Project

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is installing two Dynamic Messages Signs (DMS) at the Snapper Creek, Pompano Beach, West Palm Beach, Fort Pierce/Port St. Lucie and Fort Drum Service Plazas, for a total of 10 signs.

This project also includes installing nine Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras throughout the Turnpike Mainline/State Road (SR) 91 and Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869.

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction noise, vibration, and dust. FTE takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.
