



Turnpike Extension/SR 821 Resurfacing and Improvements Project from S. Dixie Highway/US 1 to SW 112 Avenue/SR 989

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is resurfacing the existing asphalt roadway for the Turnpike Extension/State Road (SR) 821 from S. Dixie Highway/US 1 to Biscayne Drive/SW 288 Street (Exit 5) and the Turnpike Extension ramps from Biscayne Drive (Exit 5) to SW 112 Avenue/SR 989 (Exit 9), in Miami-Dade County.

This project includes the following:

- Milling and resurfacing of northbound and southbound Turnpike Extension travel lanes, and inside and outside shoulders between S. Dixie Highway and Biscayne Drive
- Improving the ramps between Biscayne Drive and SW 112 Avenue, including milling, resurfacing
- Installing new guardrail, sign replacements, joint repairs, and lighting enhancements

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction noise, vibration, and dust. FTE takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Work is anticipated to be completed in 2021.

The project cost is approximately \$ 9 million.

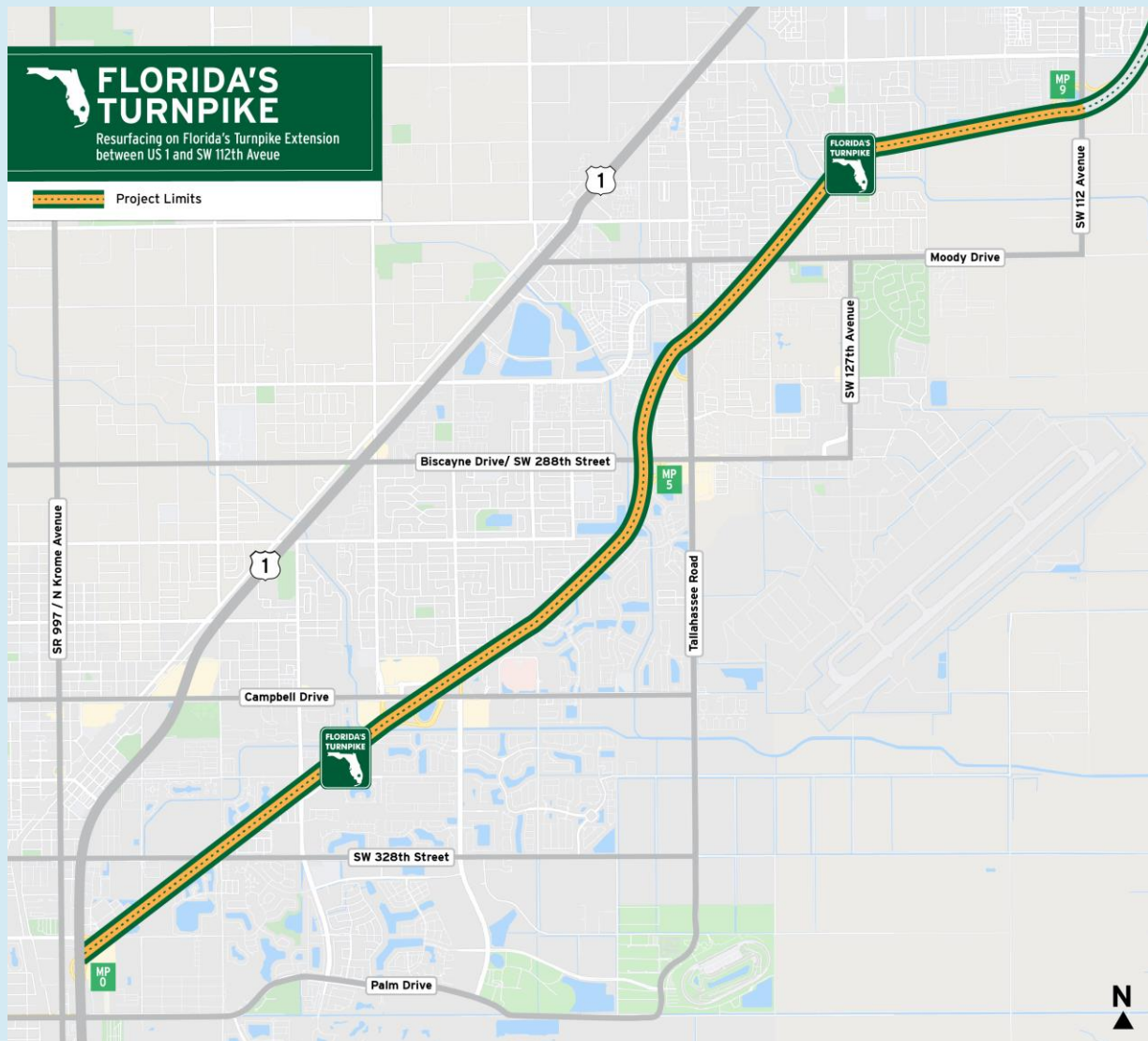
