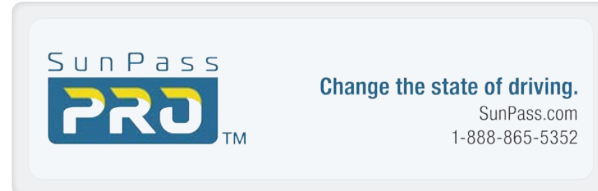

SunPass Mini™



- Sticker transponder that adheres to windshield
- Works in Florida, Georgia and North Carolina
- Not for motorcycles

SunPass PRO™



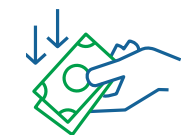
Powered by **SunPass** and **E-ZPass**

- Portable transponder that sticks to windshield with suction cups
- Works where SunPass Mini is accepted and anywhere E-ZPass is accepted (see map)
- Ideal for rentals and motorcycles

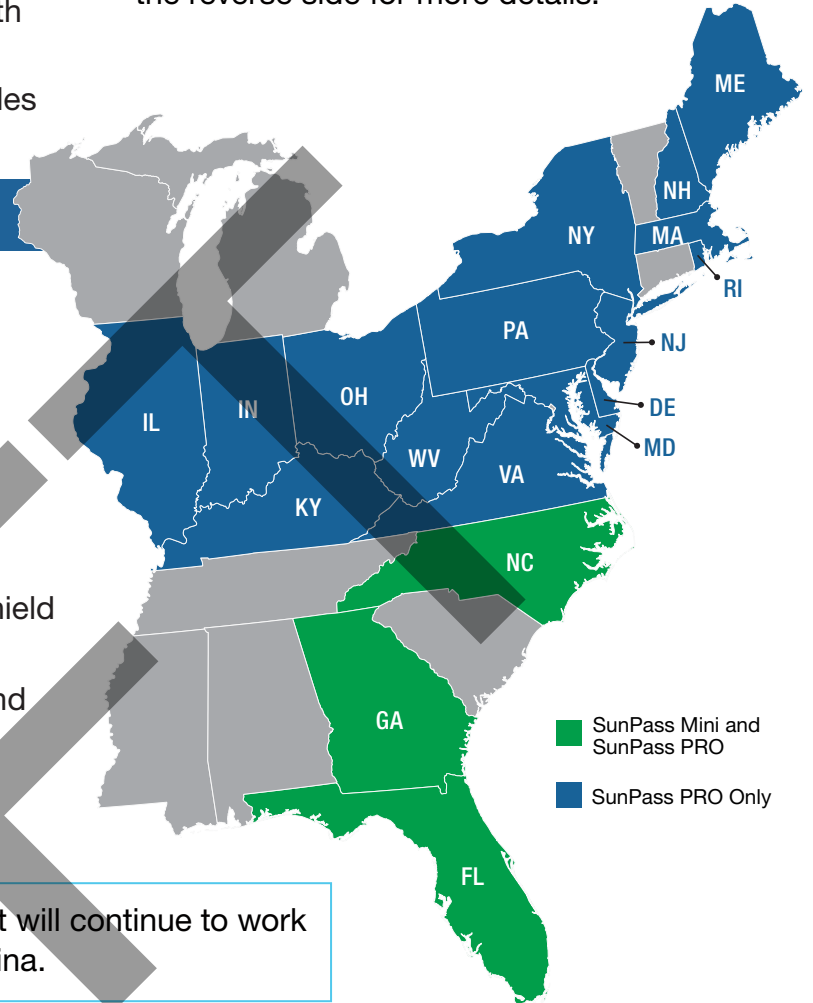

Where can you use SunPass?

SunPass can be used on toll roads and most bridges throughout Florida. SunPass transponders are interoperable, meaning they can also be used as payment for tolls in certain states. See maps below and on the reverse side for more details.



Green: SunPass Mini and SunPass PRO
Blue: SunPass PRO Only

What you need to activate:

- ID number on transponder
- Vehicle license plate number
- Payment information (\$10 minimum balance required)

Sign up for Easy Pay

With Easy Pay, when your SunPass account reaches a low balance, it will replenish automatically with a preset amount using a saved payment method.



You can also add cash to your account. Visit SunPass.com/cash for more details.




Renting a car? Take SunPass PRO with you.



- Add vehicle to your SunPass account during rental period via SunPass.com, iOS or Android app, or call 1-888-TOLL-FLA (1-888-865-5352).
- Remember to remove your SunPass transponder upon returning the vehicle.
- Check with rental agent about their toll program.



Toll Payment Options

-  SunPass or TOLL-BY-PLATE* only (cash not accepted)
-  SunPass or cash only
-  Cash only

*TOLL-BY-PLATE is an electronic toll collection system that captures an image of a vehicle's license plate when an active SunPass transponder is not detected. The vehicle's first-listed registered owner will receive an invoice for accumulated toll amounts, plus a \$2.50 administrative charge per invoice.

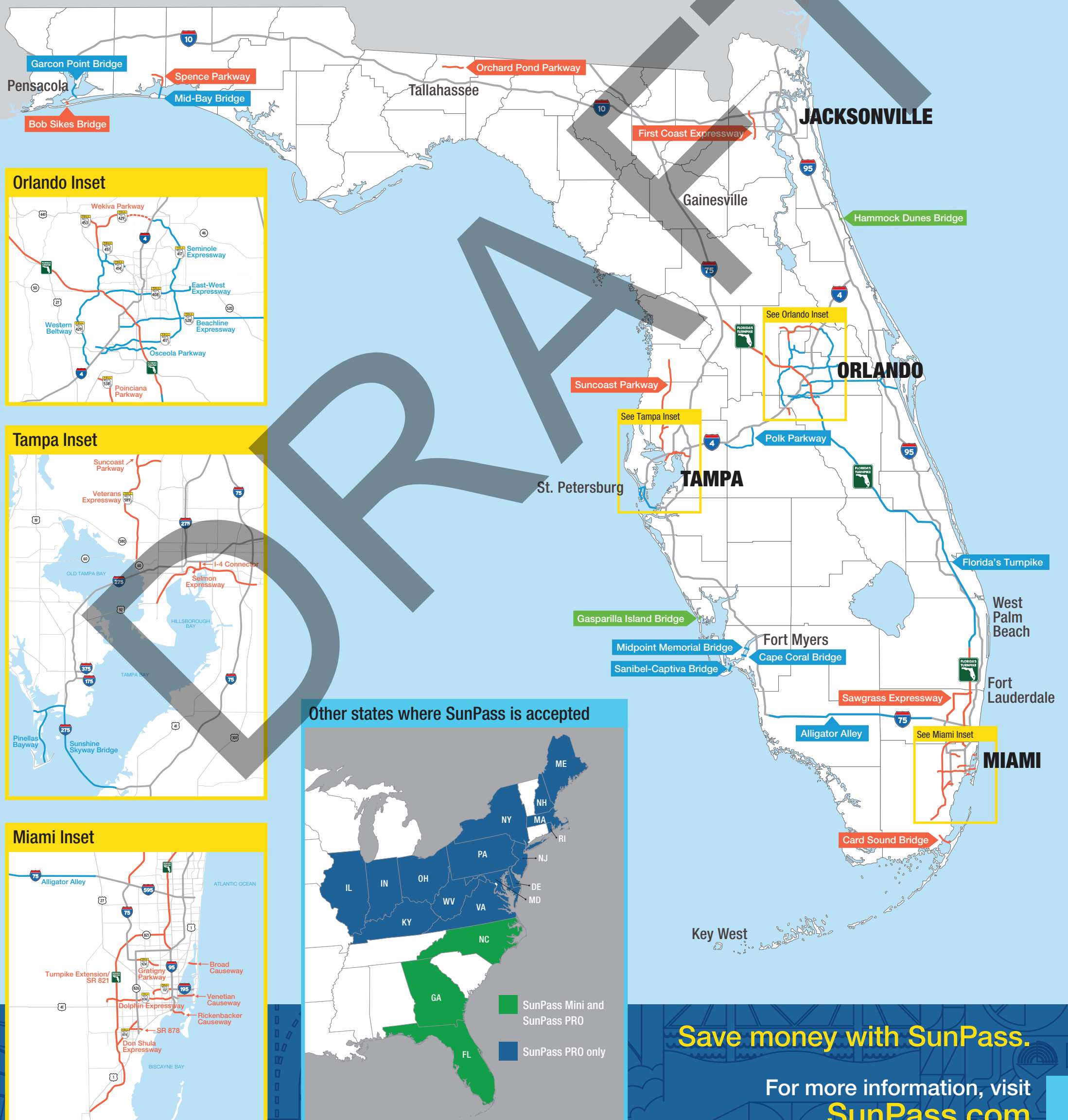
