OCOE, Fla. – [Florida's Turnpike Enterprise](#) announces lane closures and work zone information for construction and maintenance projects in Central Florida beginning Sunday, May 2. Motorists should drive with caution through work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. **Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.**

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 188 to 240) **OSCEOLA COUNTY**

ALL-ELECTRONIC TOLLING (AET) CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 ON CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 FROM THE LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THE THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA (MILEPOSTS 88-236)

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from north of Canoe Creek Service Plaza to Three Lakes Toll Plaza (Milepost 236)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, May 2, to 6 a.m. Monday, May 3.

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, May 3, and nightly through Thursday, May 6.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Work consists of providing all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals necessary for the conversion of Central Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 to an All-Electronic Tolling (AET) collection system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. The overall AET conversion scope includes the installation of new AET gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing mainline and existing toll plazas on the interchange ramps and addition of several new Dynamic Message Signs (DMS). Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$107 million.

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM MILEPOST 190 TO MILEPOST 198

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 north of the Fort Drum Service Plaza (Milepost 190 to 198)

Overnight single lane closure, 9 p.m. Sunday, May 2, to 7 a.m. Monday, May 3.

Overnight single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 10 a.m., Monday, May 3, and nightly through Thursday, May 6.

- SR 60 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to southbound Florida's Turnpike, travel south on Florida's Turnpike to exit at the Fort Drum Service Plaza (Milepost 184) and follow the detour signs to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Yeehaw Junction/US 441/SR 60 (Exit 193)

Overnight full ramp closure, 7 p.m. Tuesday, May 4, to 10 a.m. Wednesday, May 5.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access SR 60 will be directed to exit at Okeechobee Road/Ft. Pierce/SR 70 (Exit 152), travel east on Okeechobee Road to northbound I-95, travel north on I-95 and exit at Vero Beach/Lake Wales/SR 60 (Exit 147) to access SR 60.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from milepost 190 to milepost 198, in Osceola County. Work will include resurfacing the Turnpike ramps and Tandem Truck parking lot at Yeehaw Junction/SR 60 (Exit 193) and widening a portion of Florida's Turnpike at Yeehaw Junction to provide longer entrance and exit lanes. Construction will continue through 2022. Approximate cost: \$16.7 million.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 240 to 309)
OSCEOLA, ORANGE, SEMINOLE, LAKE & SUMTER COUNTIES

**ALL-ELECTRONIC TOLLING (AET) CONVERSION PROJECT
ON NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 FROM KISSIMMEE PARK ROAD TO
INTERSTATE 75 (MILEPOST 236 TO MILEPOST 309)**

Northbound and Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 just south of the Leesburg Plaza (Mileposts 285 to 287)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, May 2, and nightly through Thursday, May 6.

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, May 3, and daily through Friday, May 7.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from US 192

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, May 3, and nightly through Thursday, May 6.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Kissimmee/St. Cloud/US 192/US 441 (Exit 244)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The overall AET conversion scope includes milling and resurfacing, minor widening, lighting, highway signing, guardrail, toll facilities and other construction activities on the Northern Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 from south of Kissimmee Park Road (milepost 236) to I-75 (milepost 309) for 70 miles in Osceola, Orange, Lake and Sumter counties. Construction will continue through mid-2021. Approximate cost: \$17.5 million.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM OSCEOLA PARKWAY TO BEACHLINE EXPRESSWAY & TOLL SR 417 RAMPS

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Osceola Parkway and Beachline Expressway/SR 528 (Mileposts 249 to 255)

Overnight single lane closures, 7:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, May 2, and nightly through Thursday, May 6.

Northbound and southbound Central Florida GreeneWay/SR 417 between US 17/US 92/US 441 and Landstar Boulevard (Mileposts 11 to 14)

- Northbound Orange Blossom Trail/US 441 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to Consulate Drive, travel west on Consulate Drive to Delegates Drive, travel south on Delegates Drive to Principal Row, travel east on Principal Row to Orange Blossom Trail, travel south on Orange Blossom Trail to Osceola Parkway and travel east on Osceola Parkway to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Southbound Orange Blossom Trail/US 441 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to Osceola Parkway and travel east on Osceola Parkway to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

Eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 exit ramp to southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Exit 4)

Overnight full ramp closures, 9:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, May 2, and nightly through Tuesday, May 4.

Detour information:

- Eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to exit at Florida's Turnpike/US 17/US 92/US 441 (Exit 4), follow signs for US 17/US 92/US 441 to Consulate Drive, travel south on Consulate Drive to Orange Blossom Trail/US 441, travel south on Orange Blossom Trail to Osceola Parkway and travel east on Osceola Parkway to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

Westbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 exit ramp to northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Exit 4)

Overnight full ramp closures, 9:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, May 2, and nightly through Tuesday, May 4.

Detour information:

- Westbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to exit at Florida's Turnpike/US 17/US 92/US 441 (Exit 4), follow signs for US 17/US 92/US 441 to Landstreet Road, travel east on Landstreet Road to Orange Blossom Trail/US 441, travel south on Orange Blossom Trail to Consulate Drive, make a U-Turn and travel north on Orange Blossom Trail to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Westbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to exit at Florida's Turnpike/US 17/US 92/US 441 (Exit 4), follow signs for US 17/US 92/US 441 to Landstreet Road, travel east on Landstreet Road to Orange Blossom Trail/US 441, travel south on Orange Blossom Trail to Osceola Parkway and travel east on Osceola Parkway to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is widening the Northern Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 from four to eight lanes, between Osceola Parkway and the Beachline Expressway/SR 528. The project includes constructing three ramps at the SR 417 interchange: northbound Florida's Turnpike to southbound SR 417; southbound Florida's Turnpike to northbound SR 417; and southbound Florida's Turnpike to southbound SR 417. Other improvements are widening and/or reconstructing ramps at the Osceola Parkway and Orlando South interchanges, replacing the Florida's Turnpike bridges over the Central Florida Rail corridor and Central Florida Parkway, and replacing the roadway overpasses at Orange Avenue and Taft-Vineland Road. Construction will continue through 2021. Approximate cost: \$176 million.

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I-4 DIRECT CONNECT RAMPS TO NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 AND IMPROVEMENTS FROM BEACHLINE EXPRESSWAY TO I-4 (MILEPOSTS 253-261)

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Beachline Expressway/SR 528 (Exit 255) and I-4 (Exit 259)

Overnight double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, May 2, and nightly through Thursday, May 6.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Beachline Expressway/SR 528 (Exit 254) and south of the I-4 Interchange (Exit 259)

Long-term single lane closure through September 1, 2021. Three lanes will remain open to traffic.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from I-4, just north of the toll plaza

Long-term single lane closure through September 2, 2021. One lane will remain open to traffic.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramps from westbound I-4

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. Tuesday, May 4, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, May 5; and 10 p.m. Wednesday, May 5, to 5 a.m. Thursday, May 6.

Detour information:

- Westbound I-4 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Exit 77) will be directed to exit at Kirkman Road/SR 435 (Exit 75A), travel north on Kirkman Road to SR 408, and travel west on SR 408 to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Westbound I-4 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Exit 77) will be directed to exit at Kirkman Road (Exit 75A), travel south on Kirkman Road to W. Sand Lake Road, travel east on W. Sand Lake Road to Orange Blossom Trail/US 441/US 17/US 92, and travel south on Orange Blossom Trail to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramps to westbound I-4 (Exit 259)

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. Tuesday, May 4, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, May 5; and 10 p.m. Wednesday, May 5, to 5 a.m. Thursday, May 6.

Detour information:

- Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access westbound I-4 will be directed to continue to eastbound I-4, travel east on I-4 to Conroy Road (Exit 78) and travel west on Conroy road to access westbound I-4.

Eastbound I-4 at Kirkman Road/SR 435 (Exit 75B)

Overnight full road closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, May 2, Monday, May 3, Thursday, May 6, and Friday, May 7.

Detour information:

- Eastbound I-4 traffic wishing to continue east will be directed to exit at Kirkman Road/SR 435 (Exit 75B), travel north on Kirkman Road to Vineland Road, travel east on Vineland Road to Conroy Road and travel east on Conroy Road to access eastbound I-4.

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- Eastbound I-4 traffic wishing to access Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Exit 77) will be directed to exit at Kirkman Road/SR 435 (Exit 75B), travel north on Kirkman Road to Vineland Road, travel east on Vineland Road to Conroy Road, travel east on Conroy Road to westbound I-4, and travel west on I-4 to access Florida's Turnpike.
- Kirkman Road/SR 435 traffic wishing to access eastbound I-4 will be directed to Vineland Road, travel east on Vineland Road to Conroy Road and travel east on Conroy Road to access eastbound I-4.

Eastbound I-4 at Kirkman Road/SR 435 (Exit 75B)

Overnight full road closures, 10 p.m. Tuesday, May 4, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, May 5; and 10 p.m. Wednesday, May 5, to 5 a.m. Thursday, May 6.

*** Please note, this closure has different detours for eastbound I-4 to Florida's Turnpike, than the previous closure.**

- Eastbound I-4 traffic wishing to continue east will be directed to exit at Kirkman Road/SR 435 (Exit 75B), travel north on Kirkman Road to Vineland Road, travel east on Vineland Road to Conroy Road, and travel east on Conroy Road to access eastbound I-4.
- Eastbound I-4 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Exit 77) will be directed to exit at Kirkman Road/SR 435 (Exit 75B), travel north on Kirkman Road to SR 408 and travel west on SR 408 to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Eastbound I-4 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Exit 77) will be directed to exit at Kirkman Road (Exit 75B), travel south on Kirkman Road to W. Sand Lake Road, travel east on W. Sand Lake Road to Orange Blossom Trail/US 441/US 17/US 92 and travel south on Orange Blossom Trail to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is constructing flyover ramps to directly connect the Florida's Turnpike to and from I-4. This project includes constructing six new all-electronic tolling points, removing three existing ramp tolling points, milling, and resurfacing from south of Orange Blossom Trail to Vineland Road, and improving signalization at Consulate Drive. Other improvements include barrier and guardrail installation, highway lighting drainage and signage. Construction will continue through 2021. Approximate cost: \$85 million.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS FROM MILEPOST 260 TO MILEPOST 265

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Interstate 4 and south of SR 408 (mileposts 260 to 265), in Orange County. This project includes reconstruction of the FTE headquarters' parking lot, landscaping, and lighting upgrades. Construction will continue mid-2022. Approximate cost: \$18.9 million.

**SEMINOLE EXPRESSWAY/SR 417
RESURFACING FROM MILEPOST 38 TO MILEPOST 45**

Northbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 at Aloma Avenue (Milepost 38)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, May 2, and nightly through Thursday, May 6.

Southbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 north of SR 434 (Milepost 44.5)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, May 2, and nightly through Thursday, May 6.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing Seminole Expressway/SR 417 between Aloma Avenue/SR 426 and SR 434, in Seminole County. Improvements include median modifications, shoulder reconstruction, and new signage. Construction will continue through 2021. Approximate cost: \$12.9 million.

**SUNCOAST PARKWAY 2/SR 589
FROM US 98 TO SR 44**

Eastbound and westbound US 98 in the vicinity of the Suncoast Parkway/SR 589

Overnight single lane closures, 7:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, May 2, and nightly through Friday, May 7.

W. Oak Park Boulevard/CR 480 in the vicinity of the Suncoast Parkway/SR 589

Possible daytime intermittent single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, May 3, and daily through Friday, May 7.

W. Cardinal Street in the vicinity of the Suncoast Parkway/SR 589

SR 44 in the vicinity of the Suncoast Parkway/SR 589

Possible daytime intermittent single lane closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, May 3, and daily through Saturday, May 8.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is constructing the Suncoast Parkway 2, a four-lane toll facility that extends the existing Suncoast Parkway northward for 13 miles from US 98, in Hernando County, to SR 44, in Citrus County. Work includes constructing full interchanges at US 98 and W. Cardinal Street, a partial interchange at SR 44, a wildlife crossing and four wildlife culverts, 15 new bridges, and related drainage, lighting, highway signing, traffic signalization, guardrail, and sidewalk. The Suncoast Trail, part of Florida's Statewide Greenways and Trails System, will also be extended from US 98 to SR 44, with a pedestrian overpass constructed over US 98. Construction will continue through 2022. Approximate cost: \$135 million.

VETERANS EXPRESSWAY/SR 589 FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is installing new drainage systems on Veteran's Expressway/SR 589 from Linebaugh Avenue to Wilsky Boulevard (mileposts 7.2 to 8.2) and from Ehrlich Road to Van Dyke Road (mileposts 10.8 to 14.2), in Hillsborough County. Construction will continue through 2021. Approximate cost: \$2.5 million.

SUNCOAST PARKWAY/SR 589 NEW RIDGE ROAD INTERCHANGE

Northbound and southbound Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 south of SR 52 (Mileposts 25 to 25.5)

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, May 3, and daily through Friday, May 7.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Pasco County, in partnership with Florida's Turnpike Enterprise, is building a new interchange on Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 at Ridge Road. This project includes constructing a full interchange with access to and from northbound and southbound Suncoast Parkway, two All-Electronic Tolling facilities at the northbound entrance ramp and southbound exit ramp, Intelligent Transportation System improvements, and new signage, lighting, and pavement markings. Construction will continue through mid-2022. Approximate cost: \$11.5 million.

POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM INTERSTATE 4 (I-4) TO WESTERN TOLL PLAZA

Eastbound and westbound Polk Parkway from I-4 to Western Mainline Toll Plaza

Overnight intermittent single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, May 2, and nightly through Friday, May 7.

Eastbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 entrance ramp from eastbound I-4

Overnight single lane closure, 7 p.m. Monday, May 3, to 7 a.m. Tuesday, May 4.

Eastbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 entrance ramp from westbound I-4

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing Polk Parkway/SR 570 from Interstate 4 to the Western Toll Plaza (milepost 0-8). This project also includes improvements to bridge joints, guardrails, signing, drainage, and pavement markings. Construction will continue mid-2021. Approximate cost: \$13.5 million.

TOLL EQUIPMENT & OPERATIONS MAINTENANCE

Southbound Veterans Expressway/SR 589 exit ramp from Gunn Highway (Exit 9)

Overnight intermittent single lane closure, 10:30 p.m. Tuesday, May 4, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, May 5.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is installing Dynamic Message Sign (DMS) and Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras at the Canoe Creek, Turkey Lake, and Okahumpka Service Plazas. CCTV will also be installed along Florida's Turnpike/SR 91, SR 417, Polk Parkway/SR 570, and Veterans Expressway/Suncoast Parkway/SR 589. Arterial Dynamic Message Sign (ADMS) and CCTV cameras will also be installed along Hillsborough Avenue, Linebaugh Avenue, and Citrus Park Drive/Gunn Highway near Veterans Expressway in Hillsborough County. Construction will continue through 2022. Approximate cost: \$7.6 million.

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
