Notes:

Because of the public health crisis created by COVID-19, toll transactions and revenue have declined year-over-year beginning with the second week of March 2020. Accordingly, traffic and revenue increases in March and April 2021 are attributed to recovery from the pandemic impacts.

In September 2019 (FY 2020), tolls were suspended for four to five days for Hurricane Dorian (depending on the Turnpike segment), resulting in an approximate loss of \$12 million.
