CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 188 to 240) **OSCEOLA COUNTY**

ALL-ELECTRONIC TOLLING (AET) CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 ON CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 FROM THE LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THE THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA (MILEPOSTS 88-236)

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Okeechobee Road/Ft. Pierce/SR 70 (Exit 152) and Yeehaw Junction/SR 60 (Exit 193)

Overnight full road closure, 10 p.m. Tuesday, July 20, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, July 21; and 10 p.m. Wednesday, July 21, to 5 a.m. Thursday, July 22.

If necessary, this closure may also occur from 10 p.m. Thursday, July 22, to 5 a.m. Friday, July 23.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to continue north will be directed to exit at Okeechobee Road/Ft. Pierce/SR 70 (Exit 152), travel east on Okeechobee Road to I-95, travel north on I-95 to exit at Vero Beach/Lake Wales/SR 60 (Exit 147) and travel west on SR 60 to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Okeechobee Road/Ft. Pierce/SR 70 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to I-95, travel north on I-95 to exit at Vero Beach/Lake Wales/SR 60 (Exit 147) and travel west on SR 60 to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

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- During this closure, northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic will not be able to access the Ft. Drum Service Plaza (milepost 184). The facility's gas station, convenience store and restaurants will remain open for southbound Florida's Turnpike traffic. The Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza (milepost 144) and Canoe Creek (milepost 229) are alternate stops for northbound Florida's Turnpike drivers.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Yeehaw Junction/SR 60 (Exit 193) and Okeechobee Road/Ft. Pierce/SR 70 (Exit 152)

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to exit at Yeehaw Junction/SR 60 (Exit 193), travel east on SR 60 to I-95, travel south on I-95 to exit at Okeechobee Road/Ft. Pierce/SR 70 (Exit 129) and travel west on Okeechobee Road to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- SR 60 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to I-95, travel south on I-95 to exit at Okeechobee Road/Ft. Pierce/SR 70 (Exit 129) and travel west on Okeechobee Road to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Work consists of providing all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals necessary for the conversion of Central Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 to an All-Electronic Tolling (AET) collection system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. The overall AET conversion scope includes the installation of new AET gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing mainline and existing toll plazas on the interchange ramps and addition of several new Dynamic Message Signs (DMS). Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$107 million.

PROJECT FROM MILEPOST 190 TO MILEPOST 198**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from milepost 190 to milepost 198, in Osceola County. Work will include resurfacing the Turnpike ramps and Tandem Truck parking lot at Yeehaw Junction/SR 60 (Exit 193) and widening a portion of Florida's Turnpike at Yeehaw Junction to provide longer entrance and exit lanes. Construction will continue through 2022. Approximate cost: \$16.7 million.

**I-4 DIRECT CONNECT RAMPS TO NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 AND
IMPROVEMENTS FROM BEACHLINE EXPRESSWAY TO I-4 (MILEPOSTS 253-261)**

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Beachline Expressway/SR 528 (Exit 254) and south of the I-4 Interchange (Exit 259)

Long-term single lane closure through September 2021. Three lanes will remain open to traffic.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Beachline Expressway/SR 528 (Exit 255) and I-4 (Exit 259)

Overnight double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, July 18, and nightly through Thursday, July 22.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Beachline Expressway/US 17/US 92/US 441 (Exit 254)

Overnight full road closures, 11 p.m. Wednesday, July 21, to 5 a.m. Thursday, July 22; and 11 p.m. Thursday, July 22, to 5 a.m. Friday, July 23.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to continue north will be directed to exit at Beachline Expressway/SR 528/US 17/US 92/US 441 (Exit 254) and follow signs for south US 17/US 441, travel south on Orange Blossom Trail/US 441 to Consulate Drive, travel west on Consulate Drive to westbound Beachline Expressway, travel west on Beachline Expressway to eastbound I-4/Orlando and travel east on I-4 to access northbound Florida's Turnpike (Exit 77).
- Eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to Consulate Drive/Florida's Turnpike/US 17/US 92/US 441 (Exit 4), travel east on Consulate to Orange Blossom Trail/US 441, make a U-Turn and travel west on Consulate Drive to westbound Beachline Expressway, travel west on Beachline Expressway to eastbound I-4 Orlando and travel east on I-4 to access northbound Florida's Turnpike (Exit 77).
- Westbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Exit 4) will be directed to exit at eastbound I-4/Orlando and travel east on I-4 to access northbound Florida's Turnpike (Exit 77).
- Orange Blossom Trail/US 441 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to Consulate Drive, travel west on Consulate Drive to westbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528, travel west on Beachline Expressway to eastbound I-4/Orlando and travel east on I-4 to access northbound Florida's Turnpike (Exit 77).

Southbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to Consulate Drive (Exit 255)

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. Wednesday, July 21, to 5 a.m. Thursday, July 22; and 10 p.m. Thursday, July 22, to 5 a.m. Friday, July 23.

Detour information:

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Consulate Drive (Exit 255) will be directed to exit at Orange Blossom Trail/US 441 (Exit 254) and travel south on Orange Blossom Trail to access Consulate Drive.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from I-4, just north of the toll plaza

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access westbound I-4/Tampa will be directed to exit at I-4/Orlando/Tampa (Exit 259), follow signs for eastbound I-4/Downtown Orlando, travel east on I-4 to exit at Conroy Road (Exit 78) and travel west on Conroy Road to access westbound I-4.

Westbound I-4 exit ramps to northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Exit 77)

- Westbound I-4 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Exit 77) will be directed to exit at Kirkman Road (Exit 75B), travel south on Kirkman Road to W. Sand Lake Road, travel east on W. Sand Lake Road to Orange Blossom Trail/US 441 and travel south on Orange Blossom Trail to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is constructing flyover ramps to directly connect the Florida's Turnpike to and from I-4. This project includes constructing three new all-electronic tolling points, removing three existing ramp tolling points, milling, and resurfacing from south of Orange Blossom Trail to Vineland Road, and improving signalization at Consulate Drive. Other improvements include barrier and guardrail installation, highway lighting drainage and signage. Construction will continue through 2021. Approximate cost: \$85 million.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS FROM MILEPOST 260 TO MILEPOST 265

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Interstate 4 and south of SR 408 (mileposts 260 to 265), in Orange County. This project includes reconstructing the FTE headquarters' parking lot, landscaping, and lighting upgrades. Construction will continue mid-2022. Approximate cost: \$18.9 million.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS FROM MILEPOST 297 TO MILEPOST 309

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between CR 470 to I-75 (Mileposts 297 to 309)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, July 18, to 6 a.m. Monday, July 19.

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, July 19, and nightly through Thursday, July 22.

Daytime shoulder closures, 8 a.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, July 19, and daily through Friday, July 23.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from CR 470 to I-75, in Sumter County. This project also includes the resurfacing of entrance and exit ramps at US 301 (Exit 304), new guardrails, signage and pavement markings. Construction will continue through mid-2022. Approximate cost: \$11.5 million.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing Seminole Expressway/SR 417 between Aloma Avenue/SR 426 and SR 434, in Seminole County. Improvements include median modifications, shoulder reconstruction, and new signage. Construction will continue through 2021. Approximate cost: \$12.9 million.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is constructing the Suncoast Parkway 2, a four-lane toll facility that extends the existing Suncoast Parkway northward for 13 miles from US 98, in Hernando County, to SR 44, in Citrus County. Work includes constructing full interchanges at US 98 and W. Cardinal Street, a partial interchange at SR 44, a wildlife crossing and four wildlife culverts, 15 new bridges, and related drainage, lighting, highway signing, traffic signalization, guardrail, and sidewalk. The Suncoast Trail, part of Florida's Statewide Greenways and Trails System, will also be extended from US 98 to SR 44, with a pedestrian overpass constructed over US 98. Construction will continue through 2022. Approximate cost: \$135 million.

VETERANS EXPRESSWAY/SR 589 FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is installing new drainage systems on Veteran's Expressway/SR 589 from Linebaugh Avenue to Wilsky Boulevard (mileposts 7.2 to 8.2) and from Ehrlich Road to Van Dyke Road (mileposts 10.8 to 14.2), in Hillsborough County. Construction will continue through 2021. Approximate cost: \$2.5 million.

SUNCOAST PARKWAY/SR 589 NEW RIDGE ROAD INTERCHANGE PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 between the Anclote Toll Gantry and south of SR 52 (Mileposts 21 to 26)

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Sunday, July 18, and daily through Saturday, July 24.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Pasco County, in partnership with Florida's Turnpike Enterprise, is building a new interchange on Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 at Ridge Road. This project includes constructing a full interchange with access to and from northbound and southbound Suncoast Parkway, two All-Electronic Tolling facilities at the northbound entrance ramp and southbound exit ramp, Intelligent Transportation System improvements, and new signage, lighting, and pavement markings. Construction will continue through mid-2022. Approximate cost: \$11.5 million.

POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM INTERSTATE 4 (I-4) TO WESTERN TOLL PLAZA

Eastbound and westbound Polk Parkway from I-4 to Western Mainline Toll Plaza (Mileposts 0 to 8)

Overnight intermittent single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, July 18, and nightly through Thursday, July 22.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing Polk Parkway/SR 570 from Interstate 4 to the Western Toll Plaza (milepost 0-8). This project also includes improvements to bridge joints, guardrails, signing, drainage, and pavement markings. Construction will continue mid-2021. Approximate cost: \$13.5 million.

POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 WIDENING AND RESURFACING FROM OLD DIXIE HIGHWAY TO PACE ROAD

Eastbound and westbound Old Dixie Highway/CR 546 underneath Polk Parkway/SR 570 (Milepost 18.6)

Long-term single lane closure through January 2022. Two lanes will remain open to traffic.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is widening a four-mile segment of Polk Parkway/SR 570 to four lanes, between Old Dixie Highway/CR 546 and south of Pace Road and resurfacing the existing 4-lane portions between US 92 and I-4 in Polk County. This project includes constructing a new interchange at Polk Parkway and Braddock Road, widening Braddock Road from west of Polk Parkway to Berkley Road and constructing new electronic tolling points on Polk Parkway and Braddock Road ramps. The Eastern Toll Plaza will be relocated to south of its current location. Work consists of resurfacing and safety improvements along Polk Parkway, resurfacing the ramps at CR 546, improving signage, pavement markings, signalization lighting and drainage throughout the project and improving local roads including the realignment of the City of Auburndale Water Treatment Plant access road and the neighborhood access road south of Braddock Road, as well as minor resurfacing on Berkley Road at the Braddock Road intersection. Construction will continue through 2024. Approximate cost: \$61.2 million.

ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION PROJECT ON POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 FROM INTERSTATE 4 (I-4) TO OLD DIXIE HIGHWAY

Eastbound and westbound Polk Parkway from S. Florida Avenue to Lakeland Highlands Road (Mileposts 7 to 9)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 18, and nightly through Thursday, July 22.
