



All-Electronic Tolling (AET) Conversion Project Phase 5C on Southern Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 from Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 to Lantana Toll Plaza

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is converting the Southern Turnpike Mainline/State Road (SR) 91 to All-Electronic Tolling (AET), from the Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 to south of the Lantana Toll Plaza.

With AET, cash toll collection will be removed from the following interchanges:

- Glades Road (Exit 75)
- Atlantic Avenue (Exit 81)
- Boynton Beach Boulevard (Exit 86)

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction noise, vibration, and dust. FTE takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Construction Schedule

Work began in 2018 and is expected to be completed in late 2021.

Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$20 million.
