

Northern Turnpike Mainline Resurfacing and Safety Improvements Project from Milepost 260 to Milepost 265

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is resurfacing Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 between north of Interstate 4 and south of SR 408 (mileposts 260 to 265), in Orange County.

Work to be performed includes:

- Roadway resurfacing
- New guardrails
- Drainage improvements

This project also includes the following improvements to the FTE Headquarters' parking lot (located at milepost 263):

- Reconstruction using pervious concrete pavement
- Landscaping
- Lighting upgrades

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust. FTE takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.
