



Polk Parkway Resurfacing and Roadside Improvement Project From Interstate 4 to the Western Toll Plaza (Mileposts 0 to 8)

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) has begun a resurfacing and roadside improvements project along Polk Parkway/State Road (SR) 570. This project consists of resurfacing an eight-mile segment of Polk Parkway from Interstate 4 to the Western Toll Plaza.

Improvements include:

- Bridge joint replacements
- Guardrail installation
- Signal and lighting improvements at S. Frontage Road and Harding Boulevard
- Signing, drainage and pavement marking improvements

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust through the project's duration. FTE takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding
