



Bridge Safety Improvements at Glades Cut Off Road in St. Lucie County

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is making safety improvements to two Turnpike bridges over Glades Cut Off Road/County Road (CR) 709 (milepost 150.7), in St. Lucie County.

This project includes the following safety improvements:

- Constructing a new railroad crash wall
- Installing a new pier protection concrete barrier wall along Glades Cut Off Road/CR 709

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction noise, vibration, and dust. FTE takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic disruptions and noise.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Work is expected to be completed in mid-2022.

Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$879,000.
