Northbound Florida's Exit Ramp to Okeechobee Road Temporarily Relocated

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is scheduled to temporarily relocate the northbound Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 821 exit ramp to Okeechobee Road/US 27 (Exit 35), beginning the morning of Thursday, November 4. The relocation will allow work crews to continue bridge widening activities.

Drivers on northbound Florida's Turnpike wishing to access the exit ramp to Okeechobee Road will continue approximately 600 feet north of the current location to access the temporary ramp. The temporary exit ramp will be located after the Turnpike bridge, as shown in the aerial graphic below. This configuration will remain in place through late 2022.

Message boards have been installed along the project area to inform drivers of this change. Motorists are encouraged to use caution, drive slowly through the area, and follow the posted signage.

This work is part of the widening project along Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 821 between NW 106 Street and Interstate 75 and includes widening Okeechobee Road from west of Florida's Turnpike to east of NW 107 Avenue. This project is expected to be completed by 2025. Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or unforeseen conditions.
