

Northern Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 Improvements from Beachline Expressway/SR 528 to I-4 and I-4 Ramps to Northern Turnpike Mainline

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is providing improvements to the Northern Turnpike Mainline and select interchange ramps from just south of Orange Blossom Trail to Vineland Road in Orlando.

This project includes the following improvements:

- Constructing flyover ramps to directly connect Florida's Turnpike to and from Interstate 4 (I-4)
- Providing 10 general use toll lanes on Florida's Turnpike from the Beachline Expressway to I-4
- Constructing six new all-electronic tolling points and removing three existing ramp tolling points
- Milling and resurfacing the Northern Turnpike Mainline from just south of Orange Blossom Trail to Vineland Road
- Improving signalization at Consulate Drive
- Installing barrier and guardrail, highway lighting, drainage, and signage

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust through the project's duration. FTE takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding
