



Construction Alert

Extended Partial Closure of Park and Ride Lot at Northbound Florida's Turnpike and Lake Worth Road

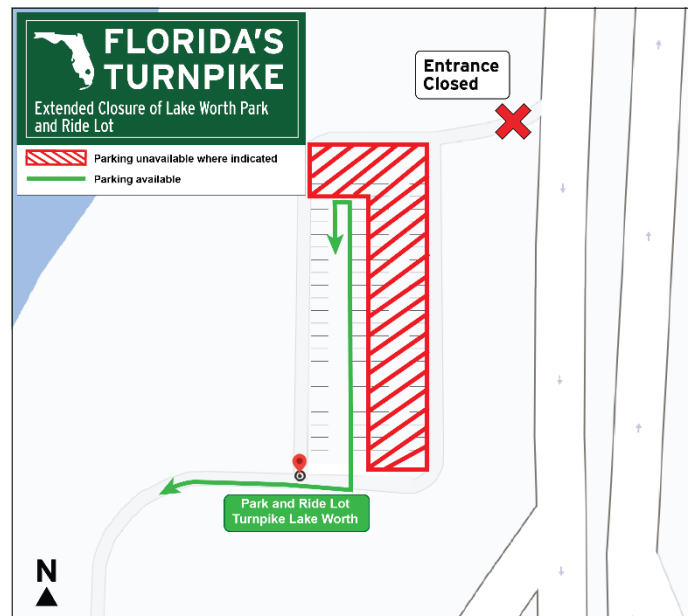
Beginning at 5 p.m. on Friday, April 22, the Lake Worth Road and Turnpike Park & Ride lot located at the northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Lake Worth Road/SR 802 (Exit 93), will remain partially closed until fall 2022, to allow crews to complete construction activities.

The Lake Worth Road and Turnpike Park & Ride lot will remain open with limited capacity. Access to the lot from the northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to Lake Worth Road will be closed. Motorists can access the park and ride lot directly from Lake Worth Road.

As an alternate, motorists can use the Palm Beach Gardens (PGA) Boulevard and Turnpike (West Indiantown Road Parking) Park & Ride lot located at the Florida's Turnpike ramp at PGA Boulevard.

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Work in this area includes plaza demolition, ramp reconstruction and parking lot repaving.

This work is part of the All-Electronic Tolling (AET) Conversion Phase 8 Project along Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from the Lantana Toll Plaza to the Three Lakes Toll Plaza. Please note, this schedule may change due to inclement weather or unforeseen conditions.
