



During the 2022 Formula 1 Miami Grand Prix on Friday, May 6, through Sunday, May 8, Florida's Turnpike Enterprise will have daily full closures on Florida's Turnpike Mainline/State Road (SR) 91.

The closures will be at the northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramps to NW 199 Street/Hard Rock Stadium (Exit 2X), the northbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp from NW 199 Street, and southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp from westbound NW 199 Street, in Miami-Dade County.

Traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

Daytime full ramp closure, 9:30 a.m. to 9:45 p.m., Friday, May 6. Daytime full ramp closure, 5 a.m. to 10:15 p.m., Saturday, May 7. Daytime full ramp closure, 6:15 a.m. to 7:15 p.m., Sunday, May 8.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramps to NW 199 Street/Stadium (Exit 2X) Detour Information:

 Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access NW 199 Street/Stadium (Exit 2X) will be directed to exit at University Drive/NW 27 Avenue/SR 817 (Exit 47) and travel south on NW 27 Avenue to access NW 199 Street.

Detour Information:

- Eastbound NW 199 Street traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to US 441/SR 7, travel north on US 441 to County Line Road/NW 215 Street/SR 852 and travel west on County Line Road to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Westbound NW 199 Street traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to NW 27 Avenue/SR 817, travel north on NW 27 Avenue to County Line Road/NW 215 Street/SR 852 and travel east on County Line Road to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from westbound NW 199 Street Detour Information:

• Westbound NW 199 Street traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to NW 27 Avenue/SR 817, travel north on NW 27 Avenue to County Line Road/NW 215 Street/SR 852 and travel east on County Line Road to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

* Please note, access to southbound Florida's Turnpike from eastbound NW 199 Street will remain open during these closures.
