



## Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 and SR 54 Interchange Improvements Project

### Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (Enterprise) is enhancing safety and mobility in Pasco County by making new improvements to the Suncoast Parkway/State Road (SR) 589 and SR 54 interchange.

Project Benefits:

- Provide improved traffic flow by constructing an additional deceleration lane for the northbound SR 589 exit ramp to SR 54 and a southbound acceleration lane for southbound and mainline traffic
- Improve traffic congestion by constructing additional turn lanes at the northbound SR 589 exit ramp
- Enhance safety by installation of new guardrails, highly reflective signage, and pavement markings

### Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust through the project's duration. The Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts, and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

#### Schedule and Funding

##### Construction Schedule

Work is anticipated to continue through mid-2023.

##### Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$ 6.7 million.
