OCOEE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and Florida's Turnpike Enterprise are providing services at all eight service plazas located along Florida Turnpike/State Road (SR 91).

The Fort Drum, Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce, West Palm Beach, Pompano Beach, and Snapper Creek Service Plazas are fully operational. The Okahumpka Service Plaza has food, fuel, and convenience store services open.

The Canoe Creek Service Plaza and the Turkey Lake Service Plaza are providing limited services. Fuel and convenience store services are open, but no restaurant services are available.
