OCOEE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and Florida's Turnpike Enterprise have resumed full operations at all eight service plazas located along Florida Turnpike/State Road (SR 91).

The Okahumpka, Turkey Lake, Canoe Creek, Fort Drum, Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce, West Palm Beach, Pompano Beach, and Snapper Creek Service Plazas are providing convenience stores, food options, and fuel services to the traveling public. The service plazas on Florida's Turnpike are located approximately every 40 miles and are open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
