



SunTrax Visual Barrier Wall Installation Along Polk Parkway/State Road 570

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is constructing a visual barrier wall along Polk Parkway/State Road 570 at the SunTrax testing facility, in Polk County. SunTrax is a large-scale, cutting-edge facility dedicated to the research, development and testing of emerging transportation technologies in safe and controlled environments.

To promote safety and innovation for a resilient transportation network, the visual barrier wall will be composed of fiberglass composite and polyvinyl chloride and is designed to withstand impacts, harsh weather, corrosive elements, and harmful ultra-violet exposure. The approximately 6,400-foot-long and 17-foot-high barrier will be lighter, longer lasting, and will be easier and less expensive to install.

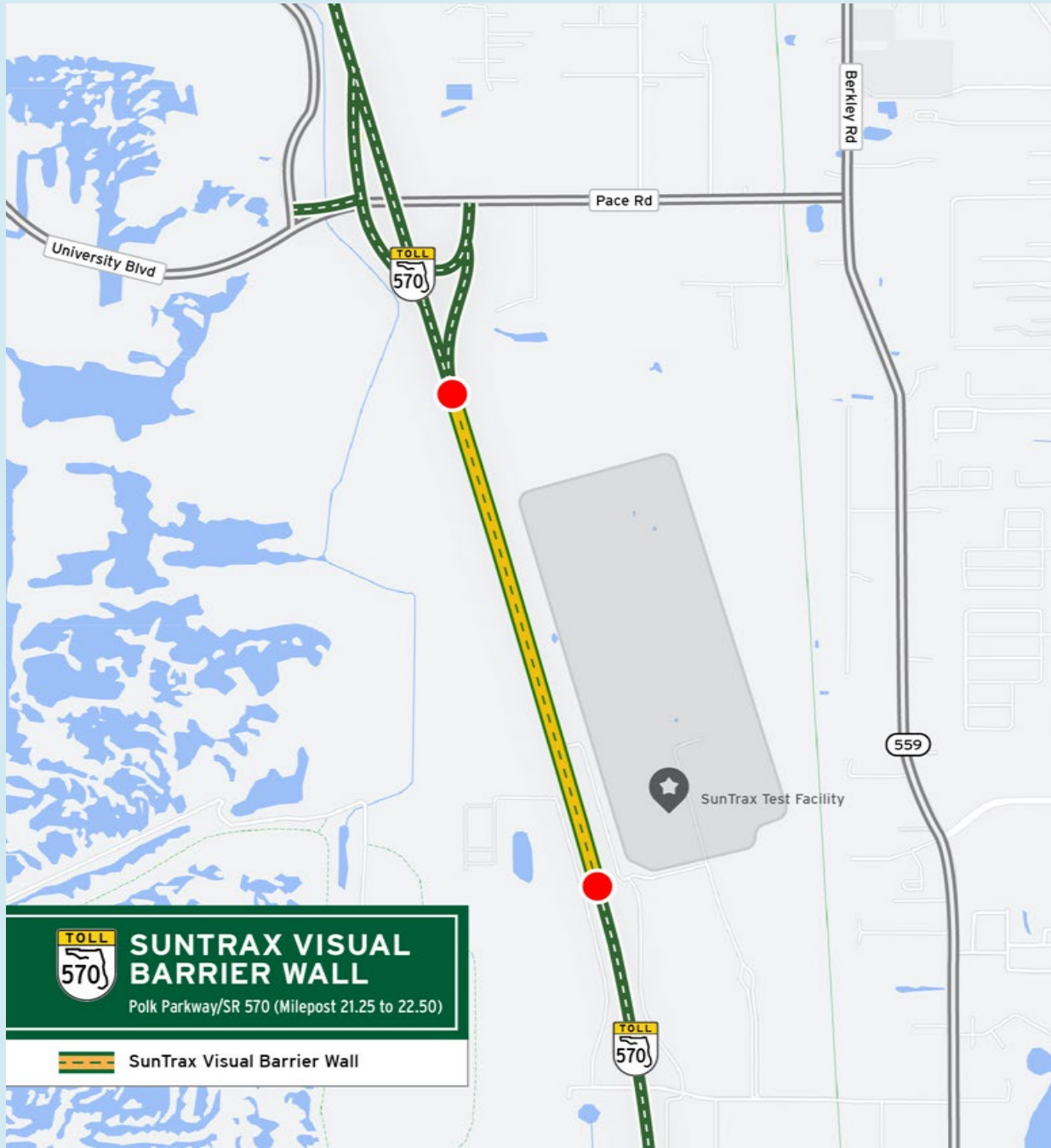
