You are invited to an Alternatives Public Information Meeting for the Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study for Widening Sawgrass Expressway (SR869) from west of US 441 to Powerline Road in Broward County. There are three participation options to select from:

- In-Person on January 31, 2023

This meeting will give interested persons an opportunity to review the project alternatives being considered, ask questions, and provide comments concerning the conceptual design, and potential social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed improvements.

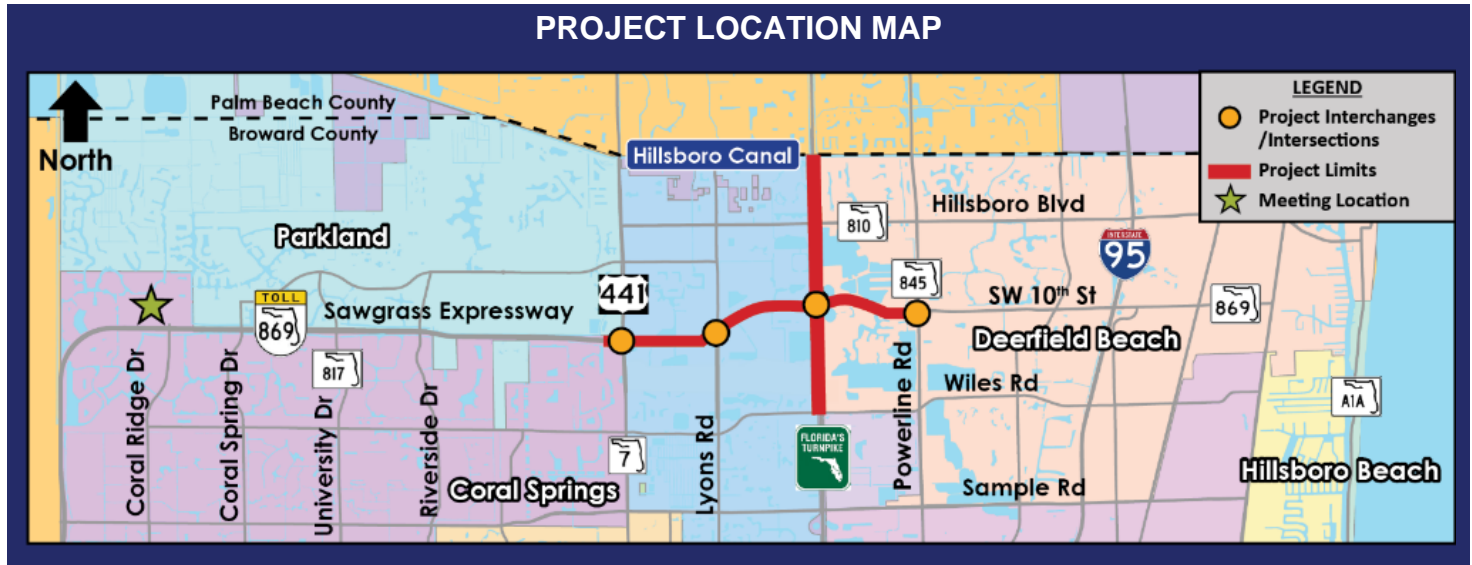

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

The proposed improvements include widening of the Sawgrass Expressway and Florida's Turnpike, new collector distributor roadway systems along the Sawgrass Expressway and improvements to the US 441, Lyons Road, and Florida's Turnpike interchanges with the Sawgrass Expressway.
