



Southbound Northern Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 Reconstruct and Safety Improvements Project from Milepost 298 to Milepost 289

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing southbound Florida's Turnpike Mainline/State Road (SR) 91 from County Road (CR) 470 to US 27 (mileposts 298 to 289), in Lake County.

This project is extending the life of the pavement and will provide safety improvements. Benefits from this project include:

- Enhancing safety by resurfacing the existing travel lanes and shoulders.
- Enhancing the local environment by rehabilitating culverts along the project limits.
- Increasing mobility by replacing signage that will allow for easier movement of motorists.
- Enhancing safety by installing new guardrail along the Mainline.
- Prolonging the life of the Palatlahaha Creek and CR 48 bridges with bridge deck expansion joint replacement and repairs.

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust. The Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

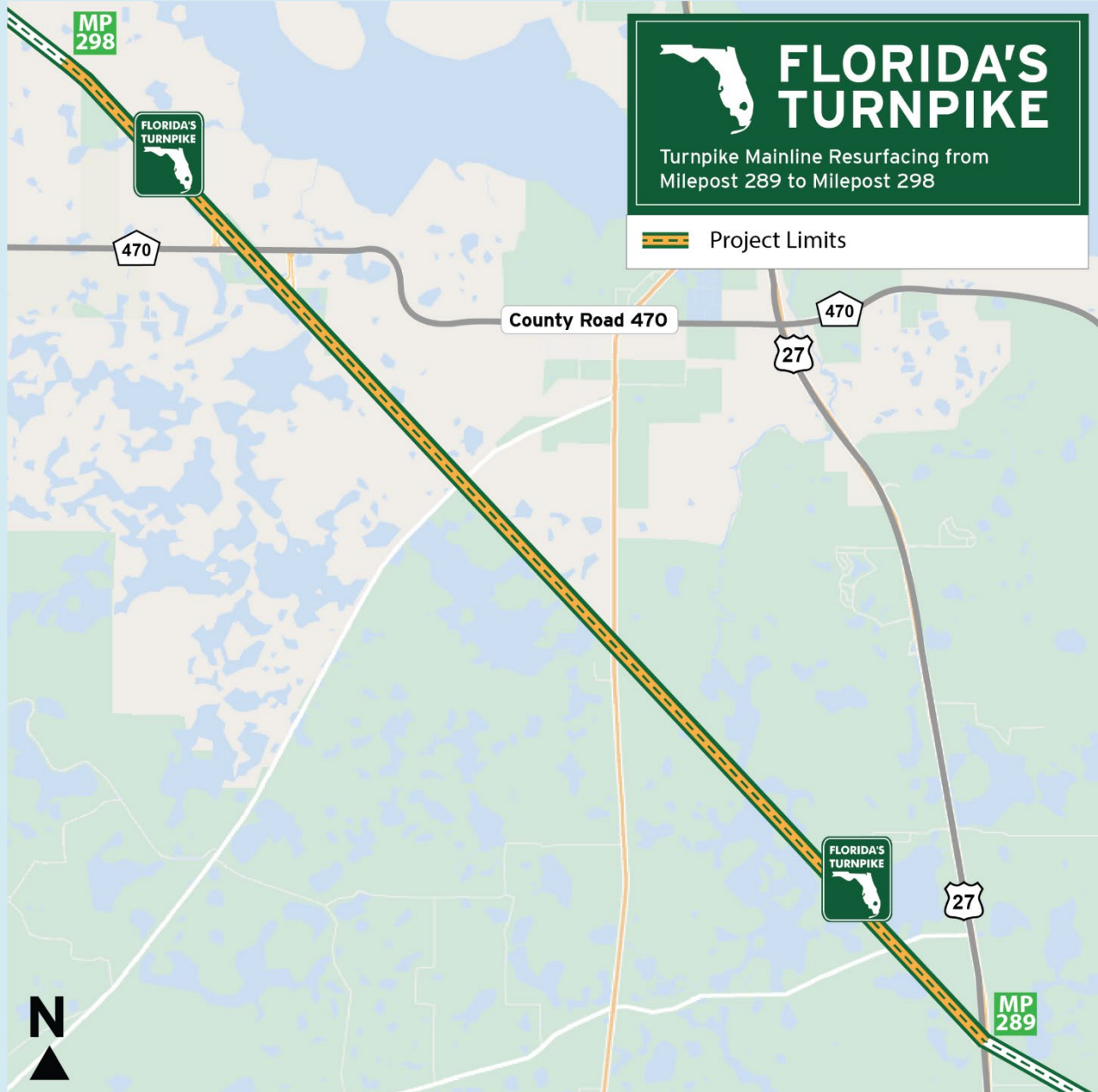
Construction Schedule
