

Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 Resurfacing Project from SR 50/Cortez Boulevard (Milepost 44.5) to US 98 (Milepost 55)

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (Enterprise) is resurfacing Suncoast Parkway/State Road (SR) 589 from SR 50/Cortez Boulevard (milepost 44.5) to US 98 (milepost 55).

This project includes the following improvements:

- Asphalt milling and resurfacing on northbound and southbound travel lanes
- Asphalt milling and resurfacing on northern SR 50 ramps
- Installation of new highly reflective pavement markings to improve visibility in all lighting and weather conditions

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust through the project's duration. The Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Work is anticipated to continue through late 2022.

Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$4.3 million.


