for widening the Florida's Turnpike Mainline (SR 91) in Palm Beach County*

Ocoee, FL — The Florida Department of Transportation, Florida's Turnpike Enterprise will hold a Design Public Information Meeting for the project to **Widen the Florida's Turnpike Mainline (SR 91) from the West Palm Beach Service Plaza to north of Okeechobee Blvd (SR 704) project in Palm Beach County, Financial Project Numbers 406143-5 and 406143-8.**
