Weekend Full Closure of Florida's Turnpike and Indiantown Road Interchange in Palm Beach County

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise has scheduled a weekend full closure at the Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 and Indiantown Road/SR 706 interchange in Palm Beach County to allow crews to complete construction activities.

To perform this work, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit and entrance ramps at Indiantown Road/SR 706/Jupiter/Okeechobee (Exit 116)

Weekend full closure, 2 a.m. Saturday, February 4, to 4 a.m. Monday, February 6.

If necessary, this closure may also occur from 2 a.m. Saturday, February 11, to 4 a.m. Monday, February 13.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Indiantown Road (Exit 116) will be directed to exit at PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 109), travel east on PGA Boulevard to I-95, travel north on I-95 to exit at Indiantown Road/SR 706/Okeechobee (Exit 87B).
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Indiantown Road (Exit 116) will be directed to exit at Stuart/SR 714 (Exit 133), travel east on SW Martin Highway to High Meadow Avenue, travel south on High Meadow Avenue to I-95, travel south on I-95 to exit at Indiantown Road/SR 706 (Exit 116).
- Eastbound and westbound Indiantown Road/SR 706 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to I-95, travel north on I-95 to exit at High Meadow Avenue/CR 713 (Exit 102), travel north on High Meadow Avenue to SW Martin Highway and travel west on SW Martin Highway to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Eastbound and westbound Indiantown Road/SR 706 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to travel east on Indiantown Road to I-95, travel south on I-95 to exit at PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 79) and travel west on PGA Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
