

Construction Update



Extended Lane Closures on Hypoluxo Road Bridge Set to Begin Tuesday, March 28

Beginning at 5 a.m. Tuesday, March 28, 2023, one lane in each direction of the Hypoluxo Road bridge over Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 will be closed for construction activities. This work is expected to continue through early 2025.

One lane in each direction of the Hypoluxo Road bridge will remain open to all traffic and emergency vehicles. Most construction activities will take place between the hours of 7 a.m. and 9 p.m., seven days a week; however, some activities can only be performed at night and during off-peak hours on the Turnpike to minimize traffic delays for most drivers.

Message boards have been installed along Hypoluxo Road to inform drivers of this change. The speed limit along this portion of Hypoluxo Road will be lowered to 35 miles per hour during these construction activities. Motorists are encouraged to use caution, drive slowly through the area, and follow the posted signage.

This work is part of the Florida's Turnpike widening project from Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to Lake Worth Road/SR 802. Please note, this schedule may change due to inclement weather or unforeseen conditions.
