



Florida's Turnpike Mainline (SR 91) Bridge Over Glades Cut Off Road Painting Project in St. Lucie County

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is repainting the Florida's Turnpike/State Road 91 bridges over Glades Cut Off Road/County Road 709 (milepost 150.7) in St. Lucie County. This project includes cleaning and repainting the steel structures of these bridges to prevent corrosion, ensuring value and quality of services to our customers.

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and night-time hours. Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions, but lane closures will be necessary to accomplish the improvements.

Closures will be announced in advance in Florida's Turnpike South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

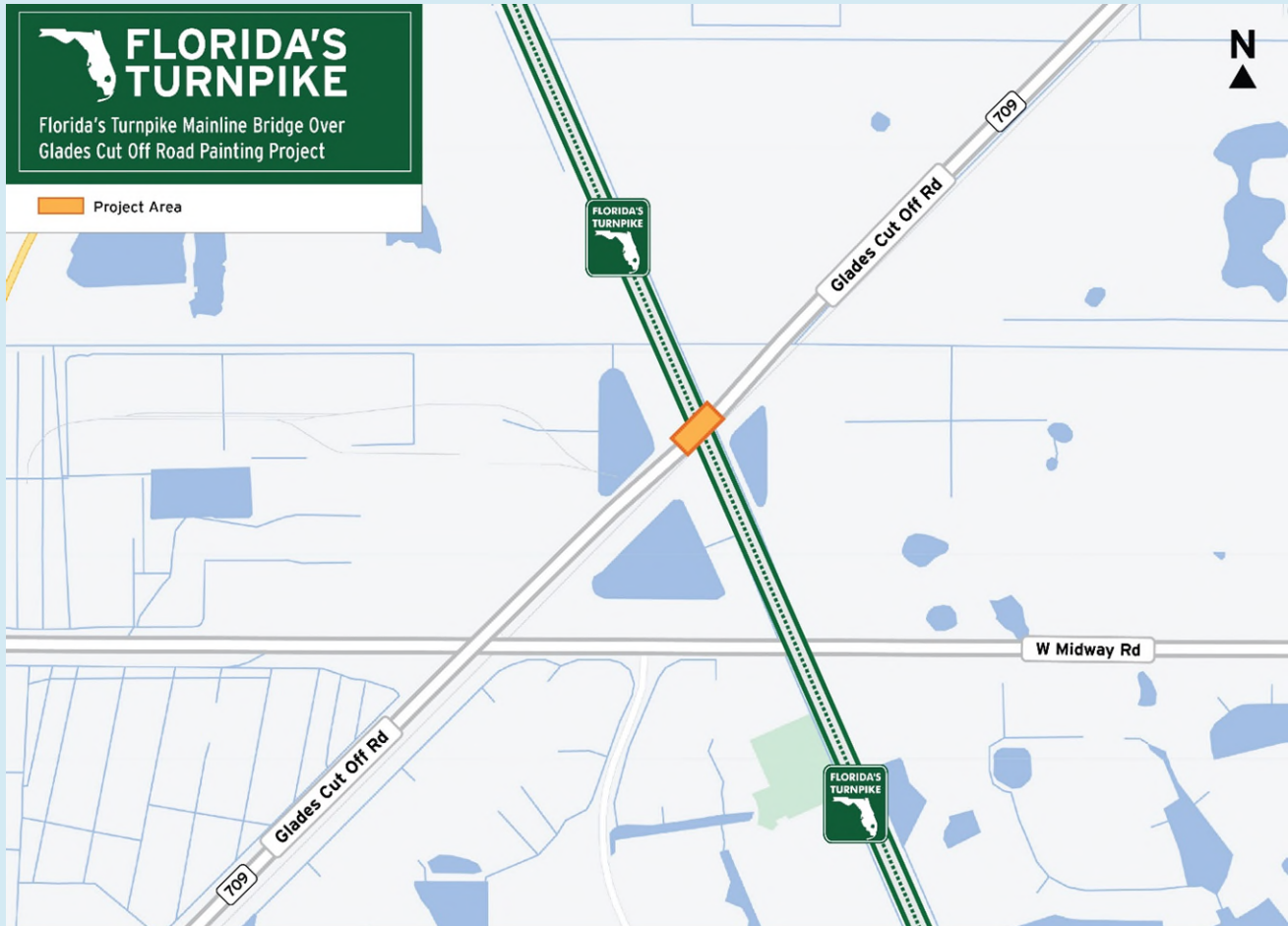
