



Polk Parkway/SR 570 Bridge Painting Project in Polk County

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is repainting seven Polk Parkway/State Road (SR) 570 bridges, in Polk County.

The life of these bridges will be prolonged by cleaning/repainting the steel components to prevent corrosion, minor structural repairs, and cleaning/repainting the concrete surfaces to reduce water infiltration. The overall aesthetics of the structures will be improved, ensuring value and quality of services for our customers.

The following bridges are included in this project:

- Polk Parkway bridges over CSX railroad, Wilkinson Road, and Beaker Road (milepost 5)
- Polk Parkway bridges over Harden Boulevard (milepost 5.5)
- Polk Parkway bridge over the onramp from Winter Lake Road (milepost 13.5)

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and night-time hours. Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions, but lane closures will be necessary to accomplish the improvements.

Closures will be announced in advance in Florida's Turnpike South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.
