

Florida's Turnpike and Kissimmee Park Road Interchange Improvements Project

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is improving the existing interchange at Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 and Kissimmee Park Road/County Road (CR) 525 (Exit 240), in Osceola County.

This project is extending the life of the pavement. Benefits from this project include:

- Increasing mobility by extending the turn lane at the entrance ramp from Kissimmee Park Road to northbound Florida's Turnpike
- Enhancing safety by installing high friction surface treatment to the asphalt to reduce skidding by resurfacing northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance and exit ramps at Kissimmee Park Road
- Increasing mobility by installing additional signage and new sign panels that allow for easier movements of motorists

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust through the project's duration. Florida's Turnpike Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$855,737.
