

Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 Resurfacing and Roadside Improvements Project from Milepost 198.5 to Milepost 207 & Milepost 248.5 to Milepost 251

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 from Milepost (MP) 198.5 to MP 207 and from MP 248.5 to MP 251 in Orange and Osceola counties.

This project is extending the life of the pavement and will provide safety improvements. Benefits from this project include:

- Improving traffic flow by repaving the roadway and widening the shoulders from MP 198.5 to MP 207
- Enhancing safety by installing new signage and guardrail, and rehabilitating existing box culverts from milepost 198.5 to milepost 207
- Provide additional safety enhancements by repaving, installing new signage and pavement markings along the southbound travel lanes from milepost 248.5 to milepost 251
- Prolonging the life of the bridges within the project limits by replacing bridge deck joints

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust. The Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Construction Schedule

Work is anticipated to continue through mid-2024.

Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$21.8 million.


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
