



Central Florida GreeneWay/SR 417 GREAT System and Crash Cushion Replacement Project

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is replacing the Guard Rail Energy Absorption Terminal (GREAT) system and crash cushions at various locations along Central Florida GreeneWay/State Road (SR) 417 in Osceola County.

Benefits of this project will include enhanced safety operations, improved maintenance operations, and crash cushion longevity. A total of 12 crash cushions will be replaced on SR 417 at the following locations:

- Celebration Toll Plaza
- Celebration Avenue
- Osceola Parkway

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, and dust throughout the project's duration. The Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

The project cost is approximately \$491,221.

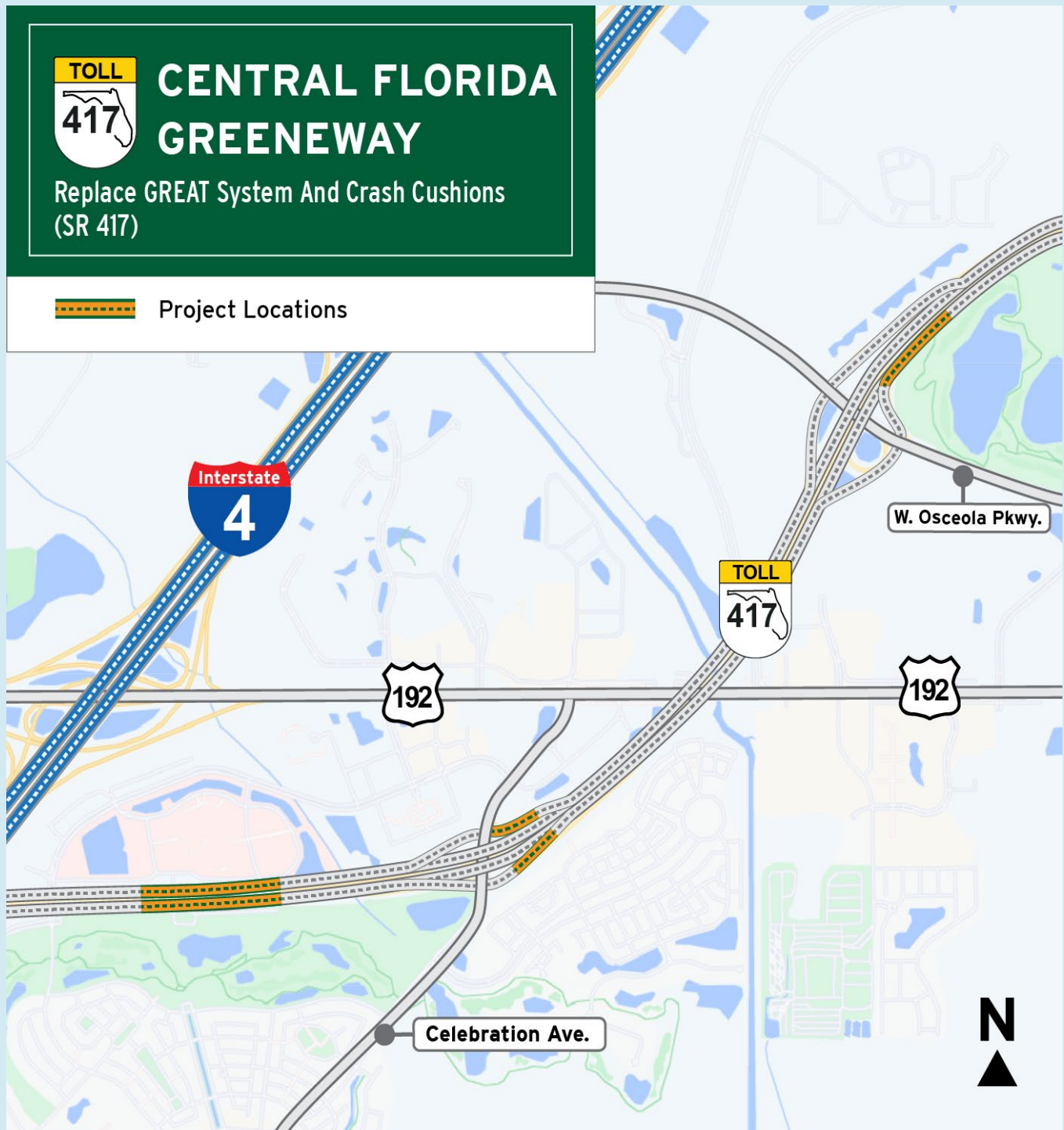
