South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory

FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla. — <u>Florida's Turnpike Enterprise</u> announces lane closures and work zone information for construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Okeechobee and Indian River counties, for the week beginning Sunday, December 31. Motorists should drive with caution through the work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.

Regularly scheduled construction and maintenance-related lane closures on Florida's Turnpike operated roads are suspended for the Christmas and New Year's Day holidays from 6 a.m. Friday, December 22, to 10 p.m. Tuesday, January 2, 2024, unless otherwise indicated below.

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 (Mileposts 0 to 47) MIAMI-DADE and BROWARD COUNTIES

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 WIDENING PROJECT FROM DOLPHIN EXPRESSWAY/SR 836 TO NW 106 STREET

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 and NW 106 Street

Overnight multiple lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, January 2, and nightly through Friday, January 5.

Eastbound and westbound NW 12 Street between Telemundo Way and NW 114 Avenue

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Tuesday, January 2, and nightly through Thursday, January 4.

Eastbound and westbound NW 25 Street between Telemundo Way and NW 114 Avenue

Daytime single lane closures, 10:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Wednesday, January 3, and Thursday, January 4.

Eastbound and westbound NW 41 Street under Florida's Turnpike/SR 821

Daytime single lane closures, 10:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Wednesday, January 3, and Thursday, January 4.

Eastbound and westbound Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 under Florida's Turnpike/SR 821

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened from six-eight lanes to 10 lanes between Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 and NW 106 Street. The project entails converting NW 117 Avenue, between NW 34 Street and NW 41 Street, into a northbound Turnpike entrance ramp and a slip ramp for local traffic continuing to NW 117 Avenue, north of NW 41 Street. Work consists of interchange improvements at SR 836 and NW 12 Street including the construction of three new ramps, and intersection improvements at NW 12 Street, NW 41 Street and NW 74 Street. Florida's Turnpike bridges over SR 836/NW 12 Street, NW 25 Street, NW 41 Street, NW 58 Street, and the NW 74 Street Canal will be widened. Work also includes constructing sound walls along qualifying residential areas, milling, and resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, drainage, signage, and lighting improvements. Construction will continue through early 2025. Approximate cost: \$245 million.

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NW 106 STREET TO INTERSTATE 75 (I-75)

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between NW 106 Street and I-75

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. Wednesday, January 3, to 6 a.m. Thursday, January 4; and 9 p.m. Thursday, January 4, to 6 a.m. Friday, January 5.

Eastbound and westbound Okeechobee Road/US 27 between NW 138 Street and NW 118 Avenue

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. Wednesday, January 3, to 6 a.m. Thursday, January 4; and 9 p.m. Thursday, January 4, to 6 a.m. Friday, January 5.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened to 10 lanes between NW 106 Street and I-75. The project entails constructing a new eastbound Okeechobee Road to southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp and a new northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to eastbound Okeechobee Road, as well as an additional lane in each direction on Okeechobee Road between west of the Turnpike and NW 107 Avenue. Work also consists of constructing a new diverging diamond interchange at Florida's Turnpike and NW 170 Street. Resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, lane striping, stormwater drainage, signage and lighting improvements will also be performed as part of this project. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$370 million.

SOUTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 0X to 86) and SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 MIAMI-DADE, BROWARD, and PALM BEACH COUNTIES

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM I-595 TO POMPANO BEACH SERVICE PLAZA

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between I-595 and Commercial Boulevard/SR 870

Overnight multiple lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Tuesday, January 2, and nightly through Thursday, January 4.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from Sunrise Boulevard/SR 838

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PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing and making roadside improvements to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from I-595 to the Pompano Beach Service Plaza in Broward County. A high friction surface treatment will be applied to the asphalt on the Mainline and existing ramps at the Sunrise Boulevard and Commercial Boulevard interchanges to reduce skidding. Improvements also include new guardrail, signage, and bridge joint repairs. Construction will continue through early 2024. Approximate cost: \$16.5 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM POMPANO SERVICE PLAZA TO SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Coconut Creek Parkway and Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight multiple lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, January 2, and nightly through Thursday, January 4.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing and making roadside improvements to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from the Pompano Beach Service Plaza to the Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 (milepost 65 to milepost 71) in Broward County. A high friction surface treatment will be applied to the asphalt on the Mainline and existing ramps at the Atlantic Boulevard, Coconut Creek Parkway and Sample Road interchanges to reduce skidding. Improvements also include new highly reflective signing and pavement markings. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$16.2 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 AND ATLANTIC BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 at Atlantic Boulevard

Overnight single and double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, January 2, and nightly through Thursday, January 4.

Eastbound and westbound Atlantic Boulevard under Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, January 2, and nightly through Thursday, January 4.

Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Wednesday, January 3, and daily through Friday, January 5.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard (Exit 5) to north of Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8). The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. Work includes reconstructing the northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway entrance and exit ramps at Atlantic Boulevard, widening Atlantic Boulevard from two to three lanes and adding bike lanes, stormwater management enhancements and modifications to the pond west of the roadway. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$72.5 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE AND COCONUT CREEK PARKWAY INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Coconut Creek Parkway/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (Exit 67)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, January 2, and nightly through Thursday, January 4.

Eastbound and westbound Coconut Creek Parkway/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard from Blount Road/NW 30 Avenue to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, January 2, and nightly through Thursday, January 4.

Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Wednesday, January 3, and daily through Friday, January 5.

Northbound NW 31 Avenue at Coconut Creek Parkway/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is improving the existing interchange at Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Coconut Creek Parkway/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (Exit 67), in Broward County. Work includes adding a second left turn lane from NW 31 Avenue to Coconut Creek Parkway and constructing an additional through lane from the Florida's Turnpike exit ramps to NW 31 Avenue. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$3.5 million.

<u>CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 86 to 188)</u> PALM BEACH, MARTIN, ST. LUCIE, and OKEECHOBEE COUNTIES

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD TO NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Lake Worth Road/SR 802

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, January 2, and nightly through Thursday, January 4.

Eastbound and westbound Hypoluxo Road over Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Extended single lane closures through early 2025. One lane in each direction will remain open to traffic.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened to four lanes in each direction, from north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804. This project also includes reconstructing the Hypoluxo Road bridge over Southern Turnpike Mainline to allow for the new road configuration. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and signal improvements are planned. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$170 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE SYSTEM STATEWIDE MIAMI-DADE, BROWARD, PALM BEACH, MARTIN, ST. LUCIE, OKEECHOBEE and INDIAN RIVER COUNTIES

SOUTH FLORIDA WRONG-WAY DETECTION TECHNOLOGY IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT

No scheduled lane closures.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is enhancing the Wrong-Way Vehicle Detection System throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, and Palm Beach counties by increasing the amount of wrong-way signage, roadway reflectors and pavement markings in locations along Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 821, Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869. Construction will continue through late 2023. Approximate cost: \$5.5 million.

SYSTEM-WIDE POWER SYSTEM HARDENING FOR INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT

No scheduled lane closures.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is enhancing the Intelligent Transportation System infrastructure throughout Miami-Dade, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Okeechobee, Osceola, Orange, Sumter, and Seminole counties. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$3.2 million.

NORTHERN & SOUTHERN QUEUE WARNING SYSTEM INSTALLATION PROJECT

No scheduled lane closures.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A queue warning system is being installed along the Turnpike system throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Orange, Osceola, and Hillsborough counties. Installation will occur along the Turnpike Extension/SR 821, Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91, Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869, Beachline Expressway/SR 528, Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429, and Veterans Expressway/SR 589. The system will alert motorists in advance of queueing or stopped traffic on the mainline that is backing up from specific congested interchanges through the Turnpike system. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$5 million.

ALL-ELECTRONIC TOLLING (AET) CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 ON CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 FROM LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramps to PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 109)

Overnight full ramp closures, 9 p.m. Wednesday, January 3, to 5 a.m. Thursday, January 4; and 9 p.m. Thursday, January 4, to 5 a.m. Friday, January 5.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access PGA Boulevard (Exit 109), will be directed to exit at Beeline Highway/SR 710 (Exit 107), travel north on Jog Road to Northlake Boulevard, travel east on Northlake Boulevard to Military Trail/SR 809, and travel north on Military Trail to PGA Boulevard/SR 786.
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access PGA Boulevard (Exit 109), will be directed to exit at Indiantown Road/SR 706 (Exit 116) and travel east on Indiantown Road to I-95, and travel south on I-95 to exit at PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 79).

- PGA Boulevard/SR 786 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to travel south on Military Trail/SR 809 to Northlake Boulevard, travel west on Northlake Boulevard to Jog Road and travel south on Jog Road to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is converting Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 to an Electronic Tolling Collection (ETC) system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. This project includes the installation of new ETC gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing mainline and existing toll plazas on the interchange ramps and addition of several new Dynamic Message Signs. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$107 million.

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
