



Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 Resurfacing and Safety Improvements Project from South of Canoe Creek Service Plaza to South of Three Lakes Toll Gantry

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing and making safety improvements to Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 from south of the Canoe Creek Service Plaza to south of the Three Lakes Toll Gantry (mileposts 227 to 235), in Osceola County.

Benefits of this project include:

- Increasing roadway longevity and resiliency by paving the road
- Enhancing safety by installing high friction surface treatment to the asphalt to reduce skidding and improve vehicle traction during adverse weather conditions
- Improving roadside safety with the installation of new guardrail and rumble strips
- Improving roadside safety with new highly reflective signing and pavement markings which will increase visibility in all lighting and weather conditions
- Installing new guardrail on S. Canoe Creek Road/County Road 523

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust through the project's duration. Florida's Turnpike Enterprise takes steps to reduce these impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Work is anticipated to continue through late 2024.

Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$16.9 million.

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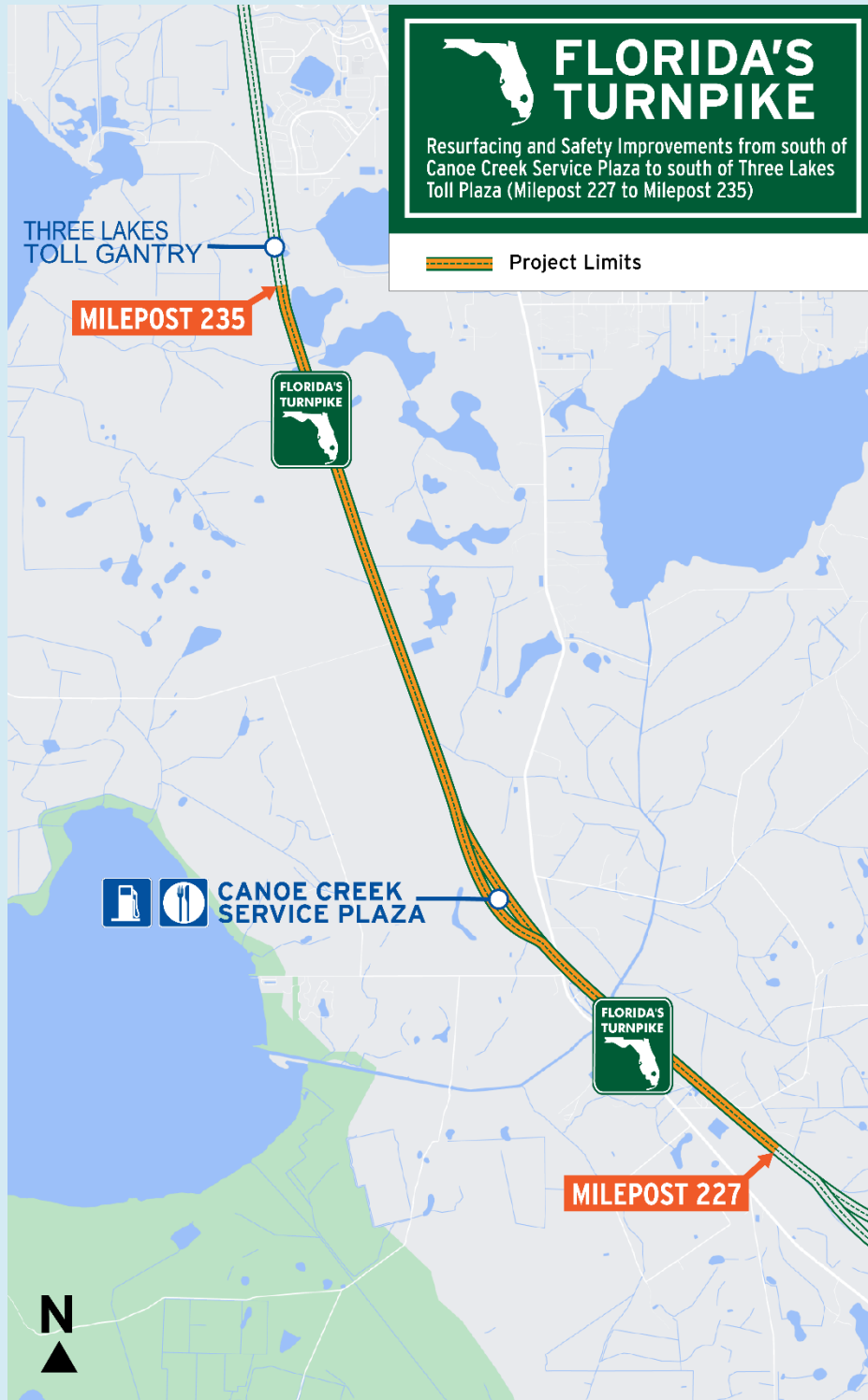
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
