TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 (Mileposts 0 to 47) **MIAMI-DADE and BROWARD COUNTIES**

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 WIDENING PROJECT FROM DOLPHIN EXPRESSWAY/SR 836 TO NW 106 STREET

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 and NW 106 Street

Overnight multiple lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, January 28, and nightly through Friday, February 2.

Eastbound and westbound NW 12 Street between Telemundo Way and NW 114 Avenue

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, January 28, and nightly through Thursday, February 1.

Eastbound and westbound NW 25 Street between Telemundo Way and NW 114 Avenue

Daytime single lane closures, 10:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, January 29, and daily through Thursday, February 1.

Eastbound and westbound NW 41 Street under Florida's Turnpike/SR 821

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened from six-eight lanes to 10 lanes between Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 and NW 106 Street. The project entails converting NW 117 Avenue, between NW 34 Street and NW 41 Street, into a northbound Turnpike entrance ramp and a slip ramp for local traffic continuing to NW 117 Avenue, north of NW 41 Street. Work consists of interchange improvements at SR 836 and NW 12 Street including the construction of three new ramps, and intersection improvements at NW 12 Street, NW 41 Street and NW 74 Street. Florida's Turnpike bridges over SR 836/NW 12 Street, NW 25 Street, NW 41 Street, NW 58 Street, and the NW 74 Street Canal will be widened. Work also includes constructing sound walls along qualifying residential areas, milling, and resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, drainage, signage, and lighting improvements. Construction will continue through early 2025. Approximate cost: \$245 million.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened to 10 lanes between NW 106 Street and I-75. The project entails constructing a new eastbound Okeechobee Road to southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp and a new northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to eastbound Okeechobee Road, as well as an additional lane in each direction on Okeechobee Road between west of the Turnpike and NW 107 Avenue. Work also consists of constructing a new diverging diamond interchange at Florida's Turnpike and NW 170 Street. Resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, lane striping, stormwater drainage, signage and lighting improvements will also be performed as part of this project. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$370 million.

A high friction surface treatment will be applied to the asphalt on the Mainline and existing ramps at the Sunrise Boulevard and Commercial Boulevard interchanges to reduce skidding. Improvements also include new guardrail, signage, and bridge joint repairs. Construction will continue through early 2024. Approximate cost: \$16.5 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM POMPANO SERVICE PLAZA TO SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Coconut Creek Parkway and Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight multiple lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, January 28, and nightly through Thursday, February 1.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing and making roadside improvements to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from the Pompano Beach Service Plaza to the Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 (milepost 65 to milepost 71) in Broward County. A high friction surface treatment will be applied to the asphalt on the Mainline and existing ramps at the Atlantic Boulevard, Coconut Creek Parkway and Sample Road interchanges to reduce skidding. Improvements also include new highly reflective signing and pavement markings. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$16.2 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 AND ATLANTIC BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. Work includes reconstructing the northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway entrance and exit ramps at Atlantic Boulevard, widening Atlantic Boulevard from two to three lanes and adding

bike lanes, stormwater management enhancements and modifications to the pond west of the roadway. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$72.5 million.

TECHNOLOGY IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is enhancing the Wrong-Way Vehicle Detection System throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, and Palm Beach counties by increasing the amount of wrong-way signage, roadway reflectors and pavement markings in locations along Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 821, Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869. Construction will continue through early 2024. Approximate cost: \$5.5 million.

**SYSTEM-WIDE POWER SYSTEM HARDENING FOR
INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT**

No scheduled lane closures.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is enhancing the Intelligent Transportation System infrastructure throughout Miami-Dade, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Okeechobee, Osceola, Orange, Sumter, and Seminole counties. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$3.2 million.

No scheduled lane closures.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A queue warning system is being installed along the Turnpike system throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Orange, Osceola, and Hillsborough counties. Installation will occur along the Turnpike Extension/SR 821, Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91, Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869, Beachline Expressway/SR 528, Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429, and Veterans Expressway/SR 589. The system will alert motorists in advance of queueing or stopped traffic on the mainline that is backing up from specific congested interchanges through the Turnpike system. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$5 million.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is converting Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 to an Electronic Tolling Collection (ETC) system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. This project includes the installation of new ETC gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing mainline and existing toll plazas on the interchange ramps and addition of several new Dynamic Message Signs. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$107 million.

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
