



Northern Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 Resurfacing and Roadside Improvements Project from Milepost 265 to Milepost 269

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is resurfacing Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 between south of SR 408 and north of SR 429 (mileposts 265 to 269), in Orange County.

This project also includes:

- Resurfacing entrance and exit ramps at SR 408, SR 50, and SR 429
- Resurfacing SR 408 from Florida's Turnpike to Old Winter Garden Road (mileposts 0 to 1.3)
- Widening the northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to SR 429
- Bridge upgrades including joint repairs, traffic railing and pedestrian fencing
- Installation of "Wrong Way Driving" signs at the SR 408 interchange ramps
- New signage, pavement markings, lighting, and drainage throughout the project

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust. FTE takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the Central and Central West Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Work is anticipated to be completed in early 2024.

Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$22 million.

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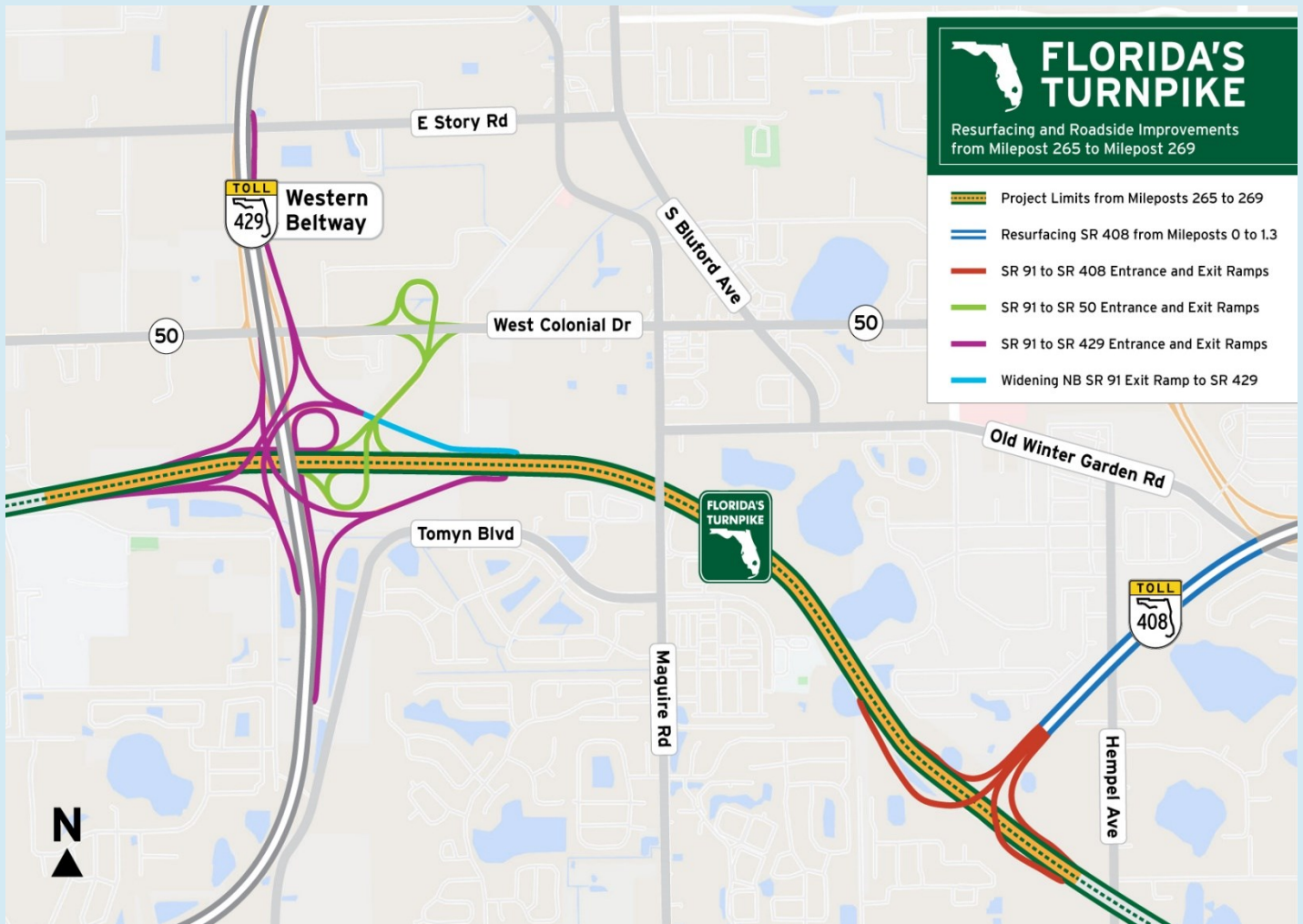
