



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Located in Broward County, Florida, the Sawgrass Expressway (SR 869) is a six – lane limited access toll facility that connects local traffic to major interstate systems such as I-75, I-595, and Florida's Turnpike (SR 91). The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is widening Sawgrass Expressway from north of Sample Road to SR 7 (US 441). The project will provide additional capacity, enhance safety and accommodate future traffic volumes resulting from increased population in Broward County.

KEY IMPROVEMENTS

- Widen the Sawgrass Expressway (SR 869) from six to ten lanes
- Convert the Coral Ridge Drive interchange to a diverging diamond interchange (DDI)
- Provide additional turn lanes at the Sawgrass Expressway exit ramps at both the Coral Ridge Drive and University Drive interchanges
- Widen bridges over Coral Ridge Drive, Coral Springs Drive, University Drive, and Riverside Drive
