

South and Central Florida Bridge Rehabilitation Project

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is rehabilitating multiple bridges along Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 throughout South and Central Florida. This project will reinforce and protect existing concrete piles, prolonging the life of the following bridges:

- C-24 Canal Bridge at milepost 142 in St. Lucie County
- Jim Green Creek Bridge at milepost 184 in Okeechobee County
- Outfall Ditch Bridge at milepost 192 in Osceola County

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust through the project's duration. Florida's Turnpike Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the weekly lane closures and work zone advisories.

Work is anticipated to continue through late 2024.

Cost and Funding


The project cost is approximately \$5 million.
