Tandem truckers should also pay special attention to the closures noted in red which include full road and mi closures and closures of special significance.

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 188 to 240) **OSCEOLA COUNTY**

ALL-ELECTRONIC TOLLING (AET) CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 ON CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 FROM LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 is being converted to an Electronic Tolling Collection (ETC) system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. This project includes the installation of new ETC gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing toll plazas on the mainline and interchange ramps. Several new Dynamic Message Signs will also be installed throughout the corridor. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$107 million.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS FROM MILEPOST 198.5 TO MILEPOST 207 & MILEPOST 248.5 TO MILEPOST 251

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Milepost 198.5 and Milepost 207

Overnight single lane closure, 8:30 p.m. Thursday, May 2, to 6 a.m. Friday, May 3.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced from mileposts 198.5 to 207 and from mileposts 248.5 to 251 in Orange and Osceola counties. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$21.8 million.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 240 to 309)
OSCEOLA, ORANGE, SEMINOLE, LAKE, and SUMTER COUNTIES

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS FROM SOUTH OF CANOE CREEK SERVICE PLAZA TO SOUTH OF THREE LAKES TOLL GANTRY

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between south of Canoe Creek Service Plaza and south of Three Lakes Toll Gantry (Milepost 227 to Milepost 235)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 28, and nightly through Friday, May 3.
Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, April 29, and daily through Friday, May 3.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced between Canoe Creek Service Plaza and Three Lakes Toll Gantry (mileposts 227 to 235), in Osceola County. This project also includes installing high friction surface treatment to the asphalt to reduce skidding and improve vehicle traction during adverse weather conditions. New signage, pavement markings, new guardrails and lighting will be installed throughout the project limits. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$16.9 million.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS FROM MILEPOST 265 TO MILEPOST 269

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to northbound and southbound Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429 (Exit 267 A)

Overnight full ramp closure, 9 p.m. Tuesday, April 30, to 6 a.m. Wednesday, May 1.

Detour Information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access northbound or southbound Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429 (Exit 267A) will be directed to exit at West Colonial Drive/SR 50 (Exit 267B) and travel west on SR 50 to access northbound or southbound SR 429.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced between Spessard L. Holland East-West Expressway/SR 408 and north of Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429 (mileposts 265 to 269), in Orange County. This project also includes resurfacing Florida's Turnpike entrance and exit ramps at SR 408, SR 50, and SR 429. SR 408 will be resurfaced from Florida's Turnpike to Old Winter Garden Road. The project will also widen the northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to SR 429. New signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting, and drainage will be installed throughout the project limits. Bridge upgrades including joint repairs, traffic railing and pedestrian fencing will also take place. Construction will continue through early 2024. Approximate cost: \$22 million.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM CLERMONT/SR 50 TO HANCOCK ROAD/MINNEOLA

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Clermont/SR 50 and Minneola/Hancock Road

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 28, and nightly through Thursday, May 2.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Hancock Road/Minneola (Exit 278) and SR 50/Clermont (Exit 272)

Overnight full road closure, 11:30 p.m. Sunday, April 28, to 5 a.m. Monday, April 29.

If necessary, this closure may also occur from 11:30 p.m. Monday, April 29, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, April 30.

Detour information:

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to exit at Hancock Road/Minneola (Exit 278), travel south on Hancock Road to SR 50 and travel east on SR 50 to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from W. Colonial Drive/SR 50

Northbound and southbound JW Jones Road underneath Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Daytime intermittent closures (flagging operations), 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, May 6, and daily through Wednesday, May 8.

Eastbound and westbound Blackstill Lake Road under Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Weekend full road closure, 10 p.m. Friday, May 3, to 5 a.m. Monday, April 28.

Detour information:

- Eastbound Blackstill Lake Road traffic wishing to continue east will be directed to Old Highway 50 W, travel east on Old Highway 50 W to County Road (CR) 455, travel north on CR 455 to Old Highway 50 E/CR 455, travel northwest on CR 455 to Ridgewood Avenue, travel west on Ridgewood Avenue to Fosgate Road and travel southwest on Fosgate Road to access Blackstill Lake Road.
- Westbound Blackstill Lake Road traffic wishing to continue west will be directed to Fosgate Road, travel northeast on Fosgate Road to Ridgewood Avenue, travel east on Ridgewood Avenue to County Road (CR) 455, travel south on CR 455 to Old Highway 50 E/CR 455, travel south on CR 455 to Old Highway 50 W and travel west on Old Highway 50 W to access Blackstill Lake Road.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from four to eight lanes from Clermont/SR 50 to Minneola/Hancock Road in Lake and Orange counties. This project includes constructing a new Fosgate Road bridge over the Turnpike. The bridges at CR 438 and CR 455 will be replaced, as well as the Turnpike bridges over Jones Road, Old Highway 50, and Blackstill Lake Road. The West Orange Trail bridge over the Turnpike will be replaced with a prefabricated structure. New electronic tolling gantries will be installed, and the existing toll booths and canopies at the SR 50 entrance and exit ramps will be demolished. Safety improvements for this project include a new Intelligent Transportation system, signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting, and drainage. Construction will continue through mid-2026. Approximate cost: \$162.3 million.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM MINNEOLA/HANCOCK ROAD TO O'BRIEN ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Minneola/Hancock Road and north of O'Brien Road

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 28, and nightly through Thursday, May 2.

Intermittent daytime shoulder closures, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, April 29, and daily through Friday, May 3.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Minneola/Montverde/Hancock Road (Exit 278) and US 27 (Exit 285)

Overnight full road closure, 10 p.m. Monday, April 29, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, April 30.

If necessary, this closure may also occur from 10 p.m. Tuesday, April 30, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, May 1.

*** Please note, this closure will not occur at the same time as the closure of Southbound Florida's Turnpike between Hancock Road/Minneola (Exit 278) and SR 50/Clermont (Exit 272).**

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to continue north will be directed to exit at Minneola (Exit 278), travel south on N. Hancock Road to Old Highway 50, travel west on Old Highway 50 to US 27 and travel north on US 27 to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to exit at Tavares/US 27/SR 19 (Exit 289), travel south on US 27 to Old Highway 50, travel east on Old Highway 50 to N. Hancock Road and travel north on N. Hancock Road to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- N. Hancock Road traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed south to Old Highway 50, travel west on Old Highway 50 to US 27 and travel north on US 27 to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- US 27/SR 19 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed south on US 27 to Old Highway 50, travel east on Old Highway 50 to N. Hancock Road and travel north on N. Hancock Road to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from four to eight lanes from Minneola to O'Brien Road in Lake County. This project includes replacing the bridges at Scrub Jay Lane, CR 561, US 19, and US 27/SR 19 South. New electronic tolling gantries and buildings will be installed, as well as new stormwater treatment facilities. Safety improvements for this project include new signage, pavement markings, signalization, and lighting. Construction will continue through late 2028. Approximate cost: \$233 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 AND CLAUDE PEPPER MEMORIAL HIGHWAY/US 27 INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Claude Pepper Memorial Highway/US 27 at Florida's Turnpike/ SR 91

Overnight single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 28, and nightly through Thursday, May 2.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Traffic operations are being improved at the interchange of Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Claude Pepper Memorial Highway/US 27 (milepost 289) in Lake County. This project includes installing wrong-way driving countermeasures, new mast arm signals on US 27 for the new left turn lane at the southbound exit ramp, new mast arm signals for the left turn to the northbound Turnpike entrance ramp and a new left turn lane at the southbound Turnpike exit ramp to US 27 (Exit 289). Construction will continue through early 2024. Approximate cost: \$2.6 million.

SEMINOLE EXPRESSWAY/SR 417 BRIDGE PAINTING PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is repainting three Seminole Expressway/SR 417 bridges over S. Orlando Drive/ US 17/92, W. Airport Boulevard, and Rinehart Road in Seminole County. The life of these bridges will be prolonged by cleaning/repainting the steel components and concrete surfaces to prevent corrosion and reduce water infiltration. This project includes minor structural repairs and improving the overall aesthetics of the structures. Construction will continue through early 2025. Approximate cost: \$1.1 million.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Veteran's Expressway Spur/SR 568 is being improved from Veterans Expressway/SR 589 to Dale Mabry Highway/SR 597 in Hillsborough County. Work includes installing high friction surface treatment to the asphalt which will improve safety, roadway softness and traction for drivers and the installation of new guardrail and pavement markings to improve visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. Construction will continue through 2024. Approximate cost: \$11.3 million.

**SUNCOAST PARKWAY/SR 589 EXPANSION
FROM SR 44 TO W. NORVELL BRYANT HIGHWAY/CR 486**

Southbound Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 entrance ramp from SR 44

Overnight shoulder lane closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 28, and nightly through Thursday, May 2.

Northbound SR 44 exit ramp to Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 (Exit 68)

This extension is a new, four-lane (two lanes in each direction) tolled roadway. Construction will continue through 2026. Approximate cost: \$103 million.

FROM INTERSTATE 4 (I-4) TO OLD DIXIE HIGHWAY**

**Eastbound and Westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 between South Florida Avenue/SR 37 (Exit 7)
and Lakeland Highlands Road/CR 37B (Exit 9)**

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, April 29, and nightly through Thursday, May 2.

**Eastbound and westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 between Bartow Road/US 98 (Exit 10) and
Winter Lake Road/SR 540 (Exit 14)**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: An 18-mile portion of Polk Parkway/SR 570 is being converted to electronic toll collection between I-4 and Old Dixie Highway/CR 546 in Polk County. This project includes constructing three new toll gantries at the Western Mainline (milepost 8), Central Mainline (milepost 13), and SR 540 New Mainline (milepost 15.5), replacing cash toll collections with electronic toll collection points and demolishing the existing Western and Central Mainline toll plazas. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$31.6 million.

The existing four-lane portion between US 92 and I-4 is being resurfaced. This project includes constructing a new interchange at Polk Parkway and Braddock Road, widening Braddock Road from west of Polk Parkway to Berkley Road and constructing new electronic tolling points on the new Braddock Road ramps. Work also consists of resurfacing the ramps at CR 546, improving signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting, and drainage throughout the project. Construction will continue through 2024. Approximate cost: \$61.2 million.

POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 BRIDGE PAINTING PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Harden Boulevard underneath Polk Parkway/SR 570

Long-term single lane closure through April 2024. Two lanes will remain open to traffic.

Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$2.5 million.
