Marshall Hampton Reserve Trailhead Opens in New Location

On April 12, 2024, the Marshall Hampton Reserve Trailhead opened to the public in its new location, approximately 3,000 feet south of its previous site along Thornhill Road. Access to the trailhead is now open and includes parking for both regular vehicles and horse trailers (with the appropriate permitting).

The trailhead was relocated to accommodate the new roadway alignment for Central Polk Parkway/State Road (SR 570B), a new two-lanes in each direction roadway beginning at Polk Parkway/SR 570 and Winter Lake Road/SR 540 and extending approximately 6.5 miles to US 17/SR 35.

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise worked closely with Polk County on the trailhead relocation to ensure it was completed within the first year of construction on this project. The Enterprise thanks the area residents and visitors for their patience during the relocation efforts.
