Florida's Turnpike Enterprise Moves to Electronic Toll Collection (ETC) on Seminole Expressway/SR 417 between Aloma Avenue and Interstate 4

Cash collection ends on JUNE 1, 2024

Ocoee, Fla. – Florida's Turnpike Enterprise will begin its implementation of Electronic Toll Collection (ETC) on Seminole Expressway/State Road (SR) 417 between Aloma Avenue (milepost 38) and Interstate 4 (milepost 55) beginning on Saturday, June 1, 2024. Cash will no longer be accepted.

This conversion is part of the Enterprise's ongoing pursuit toward more efficient business operations and customer convenience. Converting to ETC will improve safety and enhance mobility allowing drivers to keep a steady pace while entering and exiting the Seminole Expressway facility by eliminating the need to stop and pay for tolls.

Accepted toll payment methods are SunPass, a compatible transponder, or TOLL-BY-PLATE. The SunPass Prepaid Toll Program offers the lowest toll rate in Florida compared to TOLL-BY-PLATE. Plus, SunPass customers avoid the \$2.50 administrative fee for each invoice mailed. Both SunPass and TOLL-BY-Plate allow customers to link a debit or credit card to pay for future tolls. Accounts may be replenished with a card or cash.
