CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 188 to 240) **OSCEOLA COUNTY**

ALL-ELECTRONIC TOLLING (AET) CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 ON CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 FROM LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 is being converted to an Electronic Tolling Collection (ETC) system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. This project includes the installation of new ETC gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing toll plazas on the mainline and interchange ramps. Several new Dynamic Message Signs will also be installed throughout the corridor. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$107 million.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS FROM MILEPOST 198.5 TO MILEPOST 207 & MILEPOST 248.5 TO MILEPOST 251

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Milepost 198.5 and Milepost 207

Overnight single lane closure, 9 p.m. Sunday, June 23, to 6 a.m. Monday, June 24.

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, June 24, and nightly through Thursday, June 27.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced from mileposts 198.5 to 207 and from mileposts 248.5 to 251 in Orange and Osceola counties. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$21.8 million.

**NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS FROM
SOUTH OF CANOE CREEK SERVICE PLAZA TO SOUTH OF THREE LAKES TOLL GANTRY**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between south of Canoe Creek Service Plaza and south of Three Lakes Toll Gantry (Milepost 227 to Milepost 235)

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, June 24, and daily through Friday, June 28.
Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 23, and nightly through Thursday, June 27.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced between Canoe Creek Service Plaza and Three Lakes Toll Gantry (mileposts 227 to 235), in Osceola County. This project also includes installing high friction surface treatment to the asphalt to reduce skidding and improve vehicle traction during adverse weather conditions. New signage, pavement markings, new guardrails and lighting will be installed throughout the project limits. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$16.9 million.

**NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT
FROM CLERMONT/SR 50 TO HANCOCK ROAD/MINNEOLA**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Clermont/SR 50 and Minneola/Hancock Road

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 23, and nightly through Thursday, June 27.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from W. Colonial Drive/SR 50

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 23, and nightly through Thursday, June 27.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Clermont/SR 50 (Exit 272)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 23, and nightly through Thursday, June 27.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from four to eight lanes from Clermont/SR 50 to Minneola/Hancock Road in Lake and Orange counties. This project includes constructing a new Fosgate Road bridge over the Turnpike. The bridges at CR 438 and CR 455 will be replaced, as well as the Turnpike bridges over Jones Road, Old Highway 50, and Blackstill Lake Road. The West Orange Trail bridge over the Turnpike will be replaced with a prefabricated structure. New electronic tolling gantries will be installed, and the existing toll booths and canopies at the SR 50 entrance and exit ramps will be demolished. Safety improvements for this project include a new Intelligent Transportation system, signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting, and drainage. Construction will continue through mid-2026. Approximate cost: \$162.3 million.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM MINNEOLA/HANCOCK ROAD TO O'BRIEN ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Minneola/Hancock Road and north of O'Brien Road

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 23, and nightly through Thursday, June 27.

Intermittent daytime shoulder closures, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, June 24, and daily through Friday, June 28.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from N. Hancock Road

Weekend full ramp closure, 10 p.m. Friday, June 28, to 5 a.m. Monday, July 1.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from four to eight lanes from Minneola to O'Brien Road in Lake County. This project includes replacing the bridges at Scrub Jay Lane, CR 561, US 19, and US 27/SR 19 South. New electronic tolling gantries and buildings will be installed, as well as new stormwater treatment facilities. Safety improvements for this project include new signage, pavement markings, signalization, and lighting. Construction will continue through late 2028. Approximate cost: \$233 million.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 AND DANIEL WEBSTER WESTERN BELTWAY/SR 429 DMS UPGRADE AND RETROFIT PROJECT

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from southbound I-75

Overnight full ramp closures, 12 a.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, June 24, and Wednesday, June 25.

Detour information:

- Southbound I-75 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to exit at Inverness/Wildwood/SR 44 (Exit 329), travel east on SR 44 to US 301 and travel south on US 301 to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is enhancing dynamic messages signs throughout Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and the Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429 throughout Sumter, Osceola, Orange, and Martin Counties. This project includes removing and replacing overhead message boards, known as Dynamic Message Signs. Work also consists of installing up-to-date programming for the system that provides motorists with real-time safety messaging and roadway alerts. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$1.3 million.

SEMINOLE EXPRESSWAY/SR 417 BRIDGE PAINTING PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Seminole Expressway/SR 417 bridges over S. Orlando Drive/ US 17/92, W. Airport Boulevard, and Rinehart Road are being repainted in Seminole County. The life of these bridges will be prolonged by cleaning/repainting the steel components and concrete surfaces to prevent corrosion and reduce water infiltration. This project includes minor structural repairs and improving the overall aesthetics of the structures. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$1.1 million.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 is being extended three miles northward from SR 44 to W. Norvell Bryant Highway/CR 486 in Citrus County. This extension is a new, four-lane (two lanes in each direction) tolled roadway. Construction will continue through 2026. Approximate cost: \$103 million.

ALL-ELECTRONIC TOLLING (AET) CONVERSION PROJECT ON POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 FROM INTERSTATE 4 (I-4) TO OLD DIXIE HIGHWAY

Eastbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 between Bartow Road/US 98 (Exit 10) and Winter Lake Road/SR 540 (Exit 14)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 23, and nightly through Thursday, June 27.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: An 18-mile portion of Polk Parkway/SR 570 is being converted to electronic toll collection between I-4 and Old Dixie Highway/CR 546 in Polk County. This project includes constructing three new toll gantries at the Western Mainline (milepost 8), Central Mainline (milepost 13), and SR 540 New Mainline (milepost 15.5), replacing cash toll collections with electronic toll collection points and demolishing the existing Western and Central Mainline toll plazas. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$31.6 million.

POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 WIDENING AND RESURFACING FROM OLD DIXIE HIGHWAY TO PACE ROAD

Eastbound and westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 between north of Lakeland/Auburndale/US 92 and south of Pace Road (Mileposts 17 to 24)

The existing four-lane portion between US 92 and I-4 is being resurfaced. This project includes constructing a new interchange at Polk Parkway and Braddock Road, widening Braddock Road from west of Polk Parkway to Berkley Road and constructing new electronic tolling points on the new Braddock Road ramps. Work also consists of resurfacing the ramps at CR 546, improving signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting, and drainage throughout the project. Construction will continue through 2024. Approximate cost: \$61.2 million.

POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 BRIDGE PAINTING PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Seven Polk Parkway/SR 570 bridges are being repainted, in Polk County. The life of these bridges will be prolonged by cleaning/repainting the steel components to prevent corrosion, minor structural repairs, and cleaning/repainting the concrete surfaces to reduce water infiltration. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$2.5 million.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Central Polk Parkway/SR 570B, a new, four-lane (two lanes in each direction), tolled roadway is being constructed in Polk County. This new stretch of roadway will begin at Polk Parkway/SR 570 and Winter Lake Road/SR 540 and extend approximately 6.5 miles to US 17/SR 35. Construction will continue through 2029. Approximate cost: \$257 million.

NORTHERN & SOUTHERN QUEUE WARNING SYSTEM INSTALLATION PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A queue warning system is being installed along the Turnpike system throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Orange, Osceola, and Hillsborough counties. Installation will occur along the Turnpike Extension/SR 821, Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91, Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869, Beachline Expressway/SR 528, Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429, and Veterans Expressway/SR 589. The system will alert motorists in advance of queueing or stopped traffic on the mainline that is backing up from specific congested interchanges through the Turnpike system. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$5 million.

**SYSTEM-WIDE QUEUE WARNING SYSTEM
ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT**

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is enhancing the queue warning system along the Turnpike system throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Orange, Osceola, Sumter, and Hillsborough counties. Installation will occur along the Turnpike Extension/SR 821, Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91, Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869, Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429, and Veterans Expressway/SR 589. The system will alert motorists in advance of queueing or stopped traffic on the mainline that is backing up from specific congested interchanges through the Turnpike system. Construction will continue through early 2025. Approximate cost: \$6.8 million.

**SYSTEM-WIDE POWER SYSTEM HARDENING FOR
INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT**

No lane closures scheduled.
