FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla. — [Florida's Turnpike Enterprise](#) announces lane closures and work zone information for construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Okeechobee and Indian River counties, for the week beginning Sunday, June 30. Motorists should drive with caution through the work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. **Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.**

Regularly scheduled construction and maintenance-related lane closures on Florida's Turnpike operated roads are suspended for the Independence Day holiday from 6 a.m. Wednesday, July 3, to 10 p.m. Sunday, July 7, unless otherwise indicated below.

Tandem truckers should also pay special attention to the closures noted in red which include full road and ramp closures and closures of special significance.

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 (Mileposts 0 to 47) **MIAMI-DADE and BROWARD COUNTIES**

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 WIDENING PROJECT **FROM NW 106 STREET TO INTERSTATE 75 (I-75)**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between NW 106 Street and I-75

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 entrance ramp (Exit 35) from eastbound Okeechobee Road/US 27

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. Sunday, June 30, to 5 a.m. Monday, June 1; and 10 p.m. Monday, July 1, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, July 2.

Detour information:

- Okeechobee Road/US 27 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to NW 116 Way/Hialeah Gardens Blvd/NW 106 Street/ Beacon Station Blvd to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 exit ramp to eastbound Okeechobee Road/US 27 (Exit 35)

Overnight full lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, June 30, to 5 a.m. Monday, June 1; and 10 p.m. Monday, July 1, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, July 2.

Detour information:

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 traffic wishing to access eastbound Okeechobee Road/US 27 (Exit 35) will be directed to exit at Okeechobee Road/US 27 (Exit 35), travel west on Okeechobee Road to NW 117 Avenue and perform a U-turn to access eastbound Okeechobee Road.

** Please note, access from southbound Florida's Turnpike to westbound Okeechobee Road will remain open during the weekend operation.*

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 exit ramp to Eastbound Okeechobee Road/US 27 (Exit 35)

Overnight eastbound turn lane closure beginning 10 p.m. Sunday, June 30 to 5 a.m. Monday, June 1 and 10 p.m. Monday, July 1, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, July 2.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 traffic wishing to access eastbound Okeechobee Road/US 27 (Exit 35), travel west on Okeechobee Road to NW 117 Avenue and perform a U-turn to access eastbound Okeechobee Road.

** Please note, access from southbound Florida's Turnpike to westbound Okeechobee Road will remain open during the weekend operation.*

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 entrance ramp and US 27/Okeechobee Road from NW 118 Avenue

Overnight westbound turn lane closure beginning 10 p.m. Sunday, June 30 to 5 a.m. Monday, June 1 and 10 p.m. Monday, July 1, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, July 2.

Detour information:

- NW 118 Avenue traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike and northbound US 27/Okeechobee Road will be directed to travel east on Okeechobee Road/US 27 to NW 138 Street, perform a U-turn and travel west on Okeechobee Road to access northbound Florida's Turnpike and northbound US 27/Okeechobee Road.

Eastbound and westbound Okeechobee Road/US 27 between NW 138 Street and NW 118 Avenue

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.

Eastbound and westbound Frontage Road between NW 138 Street and NW 107 Avenue

Overnight flagging operations, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.

* Please note, access to businesses will be maintained.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened to 10 lanes between NW 106 Street and I-75. The project entails constructing a new eastbound Okeechobee Road to southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp and a new northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to eastbound Okeechobee Road, as well as an additional lane in each direction on Okeechobee Road between west of the Turnpike and NW 107 Avenue. Work also consists of constructing a new diverging diamond interchange at Florida's Turnpike and NW 170 Street. Resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, lane striping, stormwater drainage, signage and lighting improvements will also be performed as part of this project. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$370 million.

and SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869
MIAMI-DADE, BROWARD, and PALM BEACH COUNTIES**

GOLDEN GLADES INTERCHANGE (GGI) PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Miami Gardens Drive/NW 183 Street and I-95

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to southbound I-95

Overnight full ramp closures, 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.

Detour information:

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access southbound I-95 will be directed to exit at NW 167 Street, travel east on NW 167 Avenue to NE 6 Avenue, travel south on NE 6 Avenue to Opa-locka Boulevard, and travel west on Opa-locka Boulevard to access southbound I-95.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT
FROM POMPANO SERVICE PLAZA TO SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Coconut Creek Parkway and Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight multiple lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from Coconut Creek Parkway/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard

Overnight full ramp closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.
Detour information:

- Coconut Creek Parkway/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to US 441/SR 7, travel north on US 441 to Sample Road/SR 834 and travel east on Sample Road to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Coconut Creek Parkway/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (Exit 67)

Overnight full ramp closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.
Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Coconut Creek Parkway/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (Exit 67) will be directed to exit at Atlantic Boulevard/SR 814 (Exit 66), travel east on Atlantic Boulevard to NW 31 Avenue and travel north on NW 31 Avenue to access Coconut Creek Parkway.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced and improvements are being made from the Pompano Beach Service Plaza to Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 (milepost 65 to milepost 71) in Broward County. A high friction surface treatment will be applied to the asphalt on the Mainline and existing ramps at the Atlantic Boulevard, Coconut Creek Parkway and Sample Road interchanges to reduce skidding. Improvements also include new highly reflective signing and pavement markings. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$16.2 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE AND COCONUT CREEK PARKWAY
INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Coconut Creek Parkway/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (Exit 67)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.

Eastbound and westbound Coconut Creek Parkway/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard from Blount Road/NW 30 Avenue to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.
Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday, July 1, and daily through Tuesday, July 2.

Northbound NW 31 Avenue at Coconut Creek Parkway/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.
Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday, July 1, and daily through Tuesday, July 2.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The interchange at Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Coconut Creek Parkway/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (Exit 67) is being improved, in Broward County. Work includes adding a second left turn lane from NW 31 Avenue to Coconut Creek Parkway and constructing an additional through lane from the Florida's Turnpike exit ramps to NW 31 Avenue. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$3.5 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 AND ATLANTIC BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 at Atlantic Boulevard

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.

Eastbound and westbound Atlantic Boulevard under Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2. Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, July 1, and daily through Tuesday, July 2.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard (Exit 5) to north of Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8). The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. Work includes reconstructing the northbound and southbound entrance and exit ramps at Atlantic Boulevard, widening Atlantic Boulevard from two to three lanes and adding bike lanes, and stormwater management enhancements and modifications to the pond west of the roadway. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$72.5 million.

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 86 to 188) PALM BEACH, MARTIN, ST. LUCIE, and OKEECHOBEE COUNTIES

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD TO NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Lake Worth Road/SR 802

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, June 30, to 5 a.m. Monday, July 1.

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. Monday, July 1, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, July 2; and 10 p.m. Tuesday, July 2, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, July 3.

Eastbound and westbound Hypoluxo Road over Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Extended single lane closures through early 2025. One lane will remain open in each direction.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened to four lanes in each direction, from north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804. This project also includes reconstructing the Hypoluxo Road bridge over Southern Turnpike Mainline to allow for the new road configuration. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and signal improvements are planned. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$170 million.

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM MILEPOSTS 169 TO 178

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Milepost 169 and Milepost 178

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing and making roadside improvements to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from milepost 169 to milepost 178, in St. Lucie and Indian River counties. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$25 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE SYSTEM STATEWIDE

SOUTH AND CENTRAL FLORIDA BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Milepost 142

Overnight intermittent single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is rehabilitating multiple bridges along Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 throughout South and Central Florida. This project will reinforce and protect existing concrete piles, prolonging the life of the Turnpike bridges at milepost 142 in St. Lucie County, milepost 184 in Okeechobee County, and milepost 192 in Osceola County. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$5 million.

NORTHERN & SOUTHERN QUEUE WARNING SYSTEM INSTALLATION PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A queue warning system is being installed along the Turnpike system throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Orange, Osceola, and Hillsborough counties. Installation will occur along the Turnpike Extension/SR 821, Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91, Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869, Beachline Expressway/SR 528, Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429, and Veterans Expressway/SR 589. The system will alert motorists in advance of queueing or stopped traffic on the mainline that is backing up from specific congested interchanges through the Turnpike system. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$5 million.

**SYSTEM-WIDE QUEUE WARNING SYSTEM
ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT**

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is enhancing the queue warning system along the Turnpike system throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Orange, Osceola, Sumter, and Hillsborough counties. Installation will occur along the Turnpike Extension/SR 821, Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91, Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869, Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429, and Veterans Expressway/SR 589. The system will alert motorists in advance of queueing or stopped traffic on the mainline that is backing up from specific congested interchanges through the Turnpike system. Construction will continue through early 2025. Approximate cost: \$6.8 million.

**SYSTEM-WIDE POWER SYSTEM HARDENING FOR
INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT**

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is enhancing the Intelligent Transportation System infrastructure throughout Miami-Dade, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Okeechobee, Osceola, Orange, Sumter, and Seminole counties. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$3.2 million.

ALL-ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 ON CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 FROM LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramps at PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 109)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access PGA Boulevard (Exit 109), will be directed to exit at Beeline Highway/SR 710 (Exit 107), travel north on Jog Road to Northlake Boulevard, travel east on Northlake Boulevard to Military Trail/SR 809, and travel north on Military Trail to PGA Boulevard/SR 786.
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access PGA Boulevard (Exit 109), will be directed to exit at Indiantown Road/SR 706 (Exit 116) and travel east on Indiantown Road to I-95, and travel south on I-95 to exit at PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 79).
- PGA Boulevard/SR 786 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to travel east on PGA Boulevard to I-95, travel north on I-95 to exit at Indiantown Road/SR 706/Okeechobee (Exit 87B), and travel west on Indiantown Road to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- PGA Boulevard/SR 786 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to travel south on Military Trail/SR 809 to Northlake Boulevard, travel west on Northlake Boulevard to Jog Road and travel south on Jog Road to access southbound Florida's Turnpike

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramps at Port St. Lucie Boulevard/SR 802 (Exit 142)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 30, and nightly through Tuesday, July 2.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Port St. Lucie Boulevard (Exit 142), will be directed to exit at Becker Road (Exit 138), travel west on Becker Road to I-95, travel north on I-95 to exit at Gatlin Boulevard (Exit 118), travel east on Gatlin Boulevard to Port St. Lucie Boulevard.
- Port St. Lucie Boulevard traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to travel west on Port St. Lucie Boulevard to Gatlin Boulevard, travel west on Gatlin Boulevard to I-95, travel north on I-95 to exit at Okeechobee Road/SR 70 (Exit 129) and travel west on Okeechobee Road/SR 70 to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Port St. Lucie Boulevard (Exit 142) will be directed to exit at Okeechobee Road/SR 70/Ft Pierce (Exit 152) and travel east on Okeechobee Road/SR 70/Ft Pierce to I-95, travel south on I-95 to exit at SW Gatlin Boulevard (Exit 118), travel east on SW Gatlin Boulevard to Port St. Lucie Boulevard.

- Port St. Lucie Boulevard traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to travel west on Port St. Lucie Boulevard to Gatlin Boulevard, travel west on Gatlin Boulevard to I-95, travel south on I-95 to Becker Road (Exit 114) and travel east on Becker Road to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is converting Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 to an Electronic Tolling Collection system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. This project includes the installation of new gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing mainline and existing toll plazas on the interchange ramps and addition of several new Dynamic Message Signs. Construction will continue through mid-2024. Approximate cost: \$107 million.

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
