


HEMPEL AVENUE OVER STATE ROAD (SR) 408 BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise, part of the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), is designing improvements for the replacement of the Hempel Avenue Bridge (Bridge #750387) over State Road (SR) 408. The Hempel Avenue Bridge is located in the Gotha/Ocoee area of Orange County, approximately one-half mile northeast of the Turnpike and SR 408 Interchange.

This project is in the Design Phase, which is the third phase of the FDOT <u>project development process</u>. During this phase, construction plans, specifications, and final estimates to build a project are developed.

KEY IMPROVEMENTS

The bridge replacement will include:

- Lengthening and raising the bridge to accommodate the widening of SR 408 to four lanes in each direction underneath the bridge in a future project.
- Reconstructing the roadway approaches to the bridge with one lane and a sidewalk in each direction from Lake Hugh Drive to Broadway Street.


