FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla. — <u>Florida's Turnpike Enterprise</u> announces lane closures and work zone information for construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Okeechobee and Indian River counties, for the week beginning Sunday, September 15. Motorists should drive with caution through the work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.

Tandem truckers should also pay special attention to the closures noted in red which include full road and ramp closures and closures of special significance.

<u>TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 (Mileposts 0 to 47)</u> <u>MIAMI-DADE and BROWARD COUNTIES</u>

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NW 106 STREET TO INTERSTATE 75 (I-75)

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between NW 106 Street and I-75 Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 15, and nightly through Thursday, September 19.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 entrance ramp from Okeechobee Road/US 27 Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. Wednesday, September 18, to 5 a.m. Thursday, September 19; and 10 p.m. Thursday, September 19, to 5 a.m. Friday, September 20.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened to 10 lanes between NW 106 Street and I-75. The project entails constructing a new eastbound Okeechobee Road to southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp and a new northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to eastbound Okeechobee Road, as well as an additional lane in each direction on Okeechobee Road between west of the Turnpike and NW 107 Avenue. Work also consists of constructing a new diverging diamond interchange at Florida's Turnpike and NW 170 Street. Resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, lane striping, stormwater drainage, signage and lighting improvements will also be performed as part of this project. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$370 million.

GOLDEN GLADES INTERCHANGE (GGI) PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Miami Gardens Drive/NW 183 Street and I-95

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM POMPANO SERVICE PLAZA TO SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Coconut Creek Parkway and Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight multiple lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 15, and nightly through Thursday, September 19.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced and improvements are being made from the Pompano Beach Service Plaza to Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 (milepost 65 to milepost 71) in Broward County. A high friction surface

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treatment will be applied to the asphalt on the Mainline and existing ramps at the Atlantic Boulevard, Coconut Creek Parkway and Sample Road interchanges to reduce skidding. Improvements also include new highly reflective signing and pavement markings. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$16.2 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 AND COCONUT CREEK PARKWAY INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound NW 31 Avenue at Coconut Creek Parkway/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 15, and nightly through Thursday, September 19.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The interchange at Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Coconut Creek Parkway/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (Exit 67) is being improved, in Broward County. Work includes adding a second left turn lane from NW 31 Avenue to Coconut Creek Parkway and constructing an additional through lane from the Florida's Turnpike exit ramps to NW 31 Avenue. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$3.5 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 AND ATLANTIC BOULEVARD INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 at Atlantic Boulevard

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 15, and nightly through Thursday, September 19.

Eastbound and westbound Atlantic Boulevard under Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 15, and nightly through Thursday, September 19.

Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, September 16, and daily through Friday, September 20.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard (Exit 5) to north of Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8). The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. Work includes reconstructing the northbound and southbound entrance and exit ramps at Atlantic Boulevard, widening Atlantic Boulevard from two to three lanes and adding bike lanes, and stormwater

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management enhancements and modifications to the pond west of the roadway. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$72.5 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM US 441/SR 7 TO FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 from south of US 441/SR 7 to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Overnight single and double lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 15, and nightly through Thursday, September 19.

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance ramps from Lyons Road Overnight single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 15, and nightly through Thursday, September 19.

Northbound and southbound US 441/SR 7 between Winston Park Boulevard/Creekside Drive and NW 61 Street

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 15, and nightly through Thursday, September 19.

Northbound and southbound Lyons Road between Winston Park Boulevard and Sawgrass Boulevard/Serko Boulevard

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 from SR 7/US 441 to Florida's Turnpike Mainline/State Road (SR) 91, in Broward County. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$21 million.

<u>CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 86 to 188)</u> PALM BEACH, MARTIN, ST. LUCIE, and OKEECHOBEE COUNTIES

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD TO NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Lake Worth Road/SR 802

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, September 15, to 5 a.m. Monday, September 16. Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, September 16, and nightly through Thursday, September 19.

Eastbound and westbound Hypoluxo Road over Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 Extended single lane closures through early 2025. One lane will remain open in each direction.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened to four lanes in each direction, from north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804. This project also includes reconstructing the Hypoluxo

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Road bridge over Southern Turnpike Mainline to allow for the new road configuration. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and signal improvements are planned. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$170 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM MILEPOST 169 TO MILEPOST 178

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Milepost 169 and Milepost 178

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, September 15, and nightly through Thursday, September 19.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing and making roadside improvements to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from milepost 169 to milepost 178, in St. Lucie and Indian River counties. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$25 million.

<u>FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE SYSTEM STATEWIDE</u> <u>MIAMI-DADE, BROWARD, PALM BEACH, MARTIN, ST. LUCIE, OKEECHOBEE</u> <u>and INDIAN RIVER COUNTIES</u>

SOUTH AND CENTRAL FLORIDA BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Milepost 142

Overnight intermittent single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 15, and nightly through Thursday, September 19.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is rehabilitating multiple bridges along Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 throughout South and Central Florida. This project will reinforce and protect existing concrete piles, prolonging the life of the Turnpike bridges at milepost 142 in St. Lucie County, milepost 184 in Okeechobee County, and milepost 192 in Osceola County. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$5 million.

SYSTEM-WIDE QUEUE WARNING SYSTEM ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is enhancing the queue warning system along the Turnpike system throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Orange, Osceola, Sumter, and Hillsborough counties. Installation will occur along the Turnpike Extension/SR 821, Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91, Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869, Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429, and Veterans Expressway/SR 589. The system will alert motorists in advance of queueing or stopped traffic on the mainline that is backing up from specific congested interchanges through the Turnpike system. Construction will continue through early 2025. Approximate cost: \$6.8 million.

SYSTEM-WIDE POWER SYSTEM HARDENING FOR INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

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PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is enhancing the Intelligent Transportation System infrastructure throughout Miami-Dade, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Okeechobee, Osceola, Orange, Sumter, and Seminole counties. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$3.2 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 FROM LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramps at Beeline Highway/SR 710 (Exit 107)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, September 15, and nightly through Thursday, September 19.

Detour information:

- Indiantown Road/SR 706 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to I-95, travel north on I-95 to exit at High Meadow Avenue/CR 713 (Exit 102), travel north on High Meadow Avenue to SW Martin Highway, and travel west on SW Martin Highway to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Indiantown Road/SR 706 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to travel east on Indiantown Road to I-95, travel south on I-95 to exit at PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 79), and travel west on PGA Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Beeline Highway/SR 710 (Exit 107) will be directed to exit at Okeechobee Boulevard/SR 704 (Exit 99), travel east on Okeechobee Boulevard to Military Trail/SR 809, and travel north on Military Trail to access Beeline Highway.
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Beeline Highway/SR 710 (Exit 107) will be directed to exit at PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 109), travel east on PGA Boulevard to Military Trail/SR 809, travel south on Military Trail to Northlake Boulevard, trave west on Northlake Boulevard to Jog Road, and travel south on Jog Road to access Beeline Highway.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramps at Martin Highway/Stuart/SR 714 (Exit 133)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, September 15, and nightly through Thursday, September 19.

Detour information:

- SW Martin County Highway/SR 714 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to I-95, travel north on I-95 to exit at Becker Road (Exit 114), and travel east on Becker Road to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- SW Martin County Highway/SR 714 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to I-95, travel south on I-95 to exit at Indiantown Road/Okeechobee/SR 706 (Exit 87B), and travel west on Indiantown Road to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access SW Martin Highway/Stuart/SR 714 (Exit 133) will be directed to exit at Indiantown Road/SR 706 (Exit 116), travel east on Indiantown Road to I-95, travel north on I-95 to exit at High Meadow Avenue/CR 713 (Exit 102), and travel north on High Meadow Avenue to access SW Martin Highway.
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Martin Highway/Stuart/SR 714 (Exit

133) will be directed to exit at Becker Road (Exit 138), travel west on Becker Road to I-95, and travel south on I-95 to exit at Martin Highway/SR 714/CR 417 (Exit 110).

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramps at Becker Road (Exit 138)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, September 15, and nightly through Thursday, September 19.

Detour information:

- Becker Road traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed west on Becker Road to I-95, travel north on I-95 to exit at Gatlin Boulevard (Exit 118), travel east on Gatlin Boulevard to Port St. Lucie Boulevard, and travel east on Port St. Lucie Boulevard to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Becker Road traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to travel west on SW Becker Road to I-95, travel south on I-95, exit at SR 714/SW Martin County Highway (Exit 110), and travel east on SR 714/SW Martin County Highway to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Becker Road (Exit 138), will be directed to exit at SR 714/Stuart (Exit 133), travel west on SR 714/SW Martin County Highway to I-95, and travel north on I-95 to exit at Becker Road (Exit 114).
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Becker Road will be directed to exit at Port St. Lucie Boulevard (Exit 142), travel west on Port St. Lucie Boulevard to SW Gatlin Boulevard, travel west on SW Gatlin Boulevard to I-95, and travel south on I-95 to access Becker Road (Exit 114).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being converted to an Electronic Tolling Collection system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. This project includes the installation of new gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing mainline and existing toll plazas on the interchange ramps and addition of several new Dynamic Message Signs. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$107 million.
