FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla. — Florida's Turnpike Enterprise announces lane closures and work zone information for construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Okeechobee and Indian River counties, for the week beginning Sunday, October 13. Motorists should drive with caution through the work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.

Tandem truckers should also pay special attention to the closures noted in red which include full road and ramp closures and closures of special significance.

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 (Mileposts 0 to 47) MIAMI-DADE and BROWARD COUNTIES

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NW 106 STREET TO INTERSTATE 75 (I-75)

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between NW 106 Street and I-75 Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 13, and nightly through Thursday, October 17.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened to 10 lanes between NW 106 Street and I-75. The project entails constructing a new eastbound Okeechobee Road to southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp and a new northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to eastbound Okeechobee Road, as well as an additional lane in each direction on Okeechobee Road between west of the Turnpike and NW 107 Avenue. Work also consists of constructing a new diverging diamond interchange at Florida's Turnpike and NW 170 Street. Resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, lane striping, stormwater drainage, signage and lighting improvements will also be performed as part of this project. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$370 million.

SOUTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 0X to 86) and SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 MIAMI-DADE, BROWARD, and PALM BEACH COUNTIES

GOLDEN GLADES INTERCHANGE (GGI) PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Miami Gardens Drive/NW 183 Street and I-95

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 13, and nightly through Thursday, October 17.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT & OPERATIONS PROJECT TO ADD AUXILIARY LANES FROM TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 TO GRIFFIN ROAD/SR 818

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Turnpike Extension/SR 821 (Milepost 47) and Griffin Road (Milepost 54)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 13, and nightly through Thursday, October 17.

Overnight multiple lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 13, and nightly through Thursday, October 17.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is adding auxiliary Lanes to the Mainline/SR 91 from the Turnpike Extension/SR 821 to Griffin Road/SR 818. This project will increase roadway capacity, reduce congestion and improve travel times. The project also includes safety improvements at Hollywood Boulevard/SR 820 and SW 63 Terrace by closing the median to reduce vehicle conflict points and accidents, and at Hollywood Boulevard and S. 62 Avenue by eliminating the eastbound and westbound turn lanes. Construction will continue through 2029. Approximate cost: \$230 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM POMPANO SERVICE PLAZA TO SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced and improvements are being made from the Pompano Beach Service Plaza to Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 (milepost 65 to milepost 71) in Broward County. A high friction surface treatment will be applied to the asphalt on the Mainline and existing ramps at the Atlantic Boulevard, Coconut Creek Parkway and Sample Road interchanges to reduce skidding. Improvements also include new highly reflective signing and pavement markings. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$16.2 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 AND ATLANTIC BOULEVARD INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 at Atlantic Boulevard

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 13, and nightly through Thursday, October 17.

Southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance ramp from Atlantic Boulevard

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard (Exit 5) to north of Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8). The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. Work includes reconstructing the northbound and southbound entrance and exit ramps at Atlantic Boulevard, widening Atlantic Boulevard from two to three lanes and adding bike lanes, and stormwater management enhancements and modifications to the pond west of the roadway. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$72.5 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM US 441/SR 7 TO FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 between south of US 441/SR 7 and Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Overnight single and double lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 13, and nightly through Thursday, October 17.

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance ramps from Lyons Road Overnight single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 13, and nightly through Thursday, October 17.

Northbound and southbound US 441/SR 7 between Winston Park Boulevard/Creekside Drive and NW 61 Street

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 13, and nightly through Thursday, October 17.

Northbound and southbound Lyons Road between Winston Park Boulevard and Sawgrass Boulevard/Serko Boulevard

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 from US 441/SR 7 to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91, in Broward County. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$21 million.

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 86 to 188) PALM BEACH, MARTIN, ST. LUCIE, and OKEECHOBEE COUNTIES

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 CANAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM NORTH OF L-38 CANAL TO NORTH OF ATLANTIC AVENUE/SR 806

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Atlantic Avenue (Milepost 82)

Overnight single lane closure, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 13, and nightly through Thursday October 17.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR91 is conducting canal improvements along Florida's Turnpike Mainline/State Road (SR 91) from north of the L-38 Canal (milepost 79) to north of Atlantic Avenue/SR 806 (milepost 82) in Palm Beach County. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$30.8 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD TO NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Lake Worth Road/SR 802

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, October 13, to 5 a.m. Monday, October 14. Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, October 14, and nightly through Thursday, October 17.

Eastbound and westbound Hypoluxo Road over Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Extended single lane closures through early 2025. One lane will remain open in each direction.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened to four lanes in each direction, from north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804. This project also includes reconstructing the Hypoluxo Road bridge over Southern Turnpike Mainline to allow for the new road configuration. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and signal improvements are planned. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$170 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM MILEPOST 169 TO MILEPOST 178

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Milepost 169 and Milepost 178 Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, October 13, and nightly through Thursday, October 17.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing and making roadside improvements to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from milepost 169 to milepost 178, in St. Lucie and Indian River counties. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$25 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE SYSTEM STATEWIDE MIAMI-DADE, BROWARD, PALM BEACH, MARTIN, ST. LUCIE, OKEECHOBEE and INDIAN RIVER COUNTIES

SOUTH AND CENTRAL FLORIDA BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Milepost 184

Overnight intermittent single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 13, and nightly through Thursday, October 17.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is rehabilitating multiple bridges along Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 throughout South and Central Florida. This project will reinforce and protect existing concrete piles, prolonging the life of the Turnpike bridges at milepost 142 in St. Lucie County, milepost 184 in Okeechobee County, and milepost 192 in Osceola County. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$5 million.

SYSTEM-WIDE QUEUE WARNING SYSTEM ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is enhancing the queue warning system along the Turnpike system throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Orange, Osceola, Sumter, and Hillsborough counties. Installation will occur along the Turnpike Extension/SR 821, Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91, Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869, Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429, and Veterans Expressway/SR 589. The system will alert motorists in advance of queueing or stopped traffic on the mainline that is backing up from specific congested interchanges through the Turnpike system. Construction will continue through early 2025. Approximate cost: \$6.8 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 FROM LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramps at Lake Worth Road/SR 802 (Exit 93)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 13, and nightly through Thursday, October 17.

Detour information:

- Lake Worth Road/SR 802 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed west to US 441/SR 7, travel north on US 441 to Southern Boulevard/US 98, and travel east on Southern Boulevard to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Lake Worth Road traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to travel west on Lake Worth Road/SR 802 to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441 to Boynton Beach Boulevard, and travel east on Boynton Beach Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Lake Worth Road/SR 802 (Exit 93) will be directed to exit at Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Exit 86), travel west on Boynton Beach Boulevard to US 441/SR 7, and travel north on US 441 to access Lake Worth Road.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Lake Worth Road/SR 802 (Exit 93) will be directed to exit at Southern Boulevard (Exit 97) travel west on Southern Boulevard to US 441/SR 7, and travel south on US 441 to access Lake Worth Road.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramps at Southern Boulevard/ SR 80 (Exit 97)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 13, and nightly through Thursday, October 17.

Detour information:

- Southern Boulevard/SR 80 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441 to Lake Worth Road/SR 802, and travel east on Lake Worth Road to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Southern Boulevard/SR 80 (Exit 97) will be directed to exit at Okeechobee Boulevard/SR 704 (Exit 99), travel west on Okeechobee Boulevard to Jog Road, and travel south on Jog Road to access Southern Boulevard.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramps at Beeline Highway/SR 710 (Exit 107)

- Indiantown Road/SR 706 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Tumpike/SR 91 will be directed to travel east on Indiantown Road to I-95, travel south on I-95 to exit at PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 79), and travel west on PGA Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Beeline Highway/SR 710 (Exit 107) will be directed to exit at Okeechobee Boulevard/SR 704 (Exit 99), travel east on Okeechobee Boulevard to Military Trail/SR 809, and travel north on Military Trail to access Beeline Highway.
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Beeline Highway/SR 710 (Exit 107) will be directed to exit at PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 109), travel east on PGA Boulevard to Military Trail/SR 809, travel south on Military Trail to Northlake Boulevard, trave west on Northlake Boulevard to Jog Road, and travel south on Jog Road to access Beeline Highway.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramps at Becker Road (Exit 138)
