Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between NW 106 Street and I-75

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened to 10 lanes between NW 106 Street and I-75. The project entails constructing a new eastbound Okeechobee Road to southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp and a new northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to eastbound Okeechobee Road, as well as an additional lane in each direction on Okeechobee Road between west of the Turnpike and NW 107 Avenue. Work also consists of constructing a new diverging diamond interchange at Florida's Turnpike and NW 170 Street. Resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, lane striping, stormwater drainage, signage and lighting improvements will also be performed as part of this project. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$370 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS
MANAGEMENT & OPERATIONS PROJECT TO ADD AUXILIARY LANES
FROM TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 TO GRIFFIN ROAD/SR 818**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Turnpike Extension/SR 821 (Milepost 47) and Griffin Road/SR 818 (Milepost 54)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 27, and nightly through Thursday, October 31.

Overnight multiple lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 27, and nightly through Thursday, October 31.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is adding auxiliary Lanes to the Mainline/SR 91 from the Turnpike Extension/SR 821 to Griffin Road/SR 818. This project will increase roadway capacity, reduce congestion and improve travel times. The project also includes safety improvements at Hollywood Boulevard/SR 820 and SW 63 Terrace by closing the median to reduce vehicle conflict points and accidents, and at Hollywood Boulevard and S. 62 Avenue by eliminating the eastbound and westbound turn lanes. Construction will continue through 2029. Approximate cost: \$230 million.

FROM POMPANO SERVICE PLAZA TO SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Coconut Creek Parkway and Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight multiple lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 27, and nightly through Thursday, October 31.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from Atlantic Boulevard/SR 814

- Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Exit 21B) will be directed to exit at US 441/SR 7 South (Exit 18A), travel south on US 441 to Sample Road/SR 834, and travel east on Sample Road to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced and improvements are being made from the Pompano Beach Service Plaza to Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 (milepost 65 to milepost 71) in Broward County. A high friction surface treatment will be applied to the asphalt on the Mainline and existing ramps at the Atlantic Boulevard, Coconut Creek Parkway and Sample Road interchanges to reduce skidding. Improvements also include new highly reflective signing and pavement markings. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$16.2 million.

**SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 AND ATLANTIC BOULEVARD
INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 at Atlantic Boulevard

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 27, and nightly through Thursday, October 31.

Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance ramp from Atlantic Boulevard

Overnight full ramp closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, October 29, and nightly through Thursday, October 31.

Detour information:

- Atlantic Boulevard traffic wishing to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 will be directed to Coral Ridge/NW 100 Avenue/Nob Hill Road, travel north Coral Ridge/NW 100 Avenue/Nob Hill Road to Sample Road, and travel west on Sample Road to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway.

Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 exit ramp to Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8)

Overnight full ramp closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, October 29, and nightly through Thursday, October 31.

- Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 traffic wishing to access Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8) will be directed to exit at Commercial Boulevard/SR 870 (Exit 5), travel east on Commercial Boulevard/SR 870 to Coral Ridge Drive/NW 100 Avenue/Nob Hill Road and travel north on Coral Ridge Drive/NW 100 Avenue/Nob Hill Road to access Atlantic Boulevard.

Eastbound and westbound Atlantic Boulevard underneath Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 27, and nightly through Thursday, October 31.

Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, October 28, and daily through Friday, November 1.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard (Exit 5) to north of Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8). The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. Work includes reconstructing the northbound and southbound entrance and exit ramps at Atlantic Boulevard, widening Atlantic Boulevard from two to three lanes and adding bike lanes, and stormwater management enhancements and modifications to the pond west of the roadway. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$72.5 million.

**SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS
PROJECT FROM US 441/SR 7 TO FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91**

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 between south of US 441/SR 7 and Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Overnight single and double lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 27, and nightly through Thursday, October 31.

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance ramps from Lyons Road

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 CANAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT
FROM NORTH OF L-38 CANAL TO NORTH OF ATLANTIC AVENUE/SR 806**

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Atlantic Avenue (Milepost 82)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 27, and nightly through Thursday October 31.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR91 is conducting canal improvements along Florida's Turnpike Mainline/State Road (SR 91) from north of the L-38 Canal (milepost 79) to north of Atlantic Avenue/SR 806 (milepost 82) in Palm Beach County. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$30.8 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT
FROM NORTH OF BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD TO NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Lake Worth Road/SR 802

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, October 27, to 5 a.m. Monday, October 28.
Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, October 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 31.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Lake Worth Road/SR 802 (Exit 93) and Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Exit 86)

Overnight full road closures, 8 p.m. Wednesday, October 30, to 5 a.m. Thursday, October 31; and 8 p.m. Thursday, October 31, to 5 a.m. Friday, November 1.

Detour information:

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to exit at Lake Worth Road/SR 802 (Exit 93), travel west on Lake Worth Road to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441 to Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804, and travel east on Boynton Beach Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Lake Worth Road/SR 802 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441 to Boynton Beach Boulevard, and travel east on Boynton Beach Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

Eastbound and westbound Hypoluxo Road over Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Extended single lane closures through early 2025. One lane will remain open in each direction.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened to four lanes in each direction, from north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804. This project also includes reconstructing the Hypoluxo Road bridge over Southern Turnpike Mainline to allow for the new road configuration. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and signal improvements are planned. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$170 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM MILEPOST 169 TO MILEPOST 178

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Milepost 169 and Milepost 178

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, October 27, and nightly through Thursday, October 31.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing and making roadside improvements to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from milepost 169 to milepost 178, in St. Lucie and Indian River counties. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$25 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE SYSTEM STATEWIDE MIAMI-DADE, BROWARD, PALM BEACH, MARTIN, ST. LUCIE, OKEECHOBEE and INDIAN RIVER COUNTIES

SOUTH AND CENTRAL FLORIDA BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Milepost 184

Overnight intermittent single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 27, and nightly through Thursday, October 31.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is rehabilitating multiple bridges along Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 throughout South and Central Florida. This project will reinforce and protect existing concrete piles, prolonging the life of the Turnpike bridges at milepost 142 in St. Lucie County, milepost 184 in Okeechobee County, and milepost 192 in Osceola County. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$5 million.

SYSTEM-WIDE QUEUE WARNING SYSTEM ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is enhancing the queue warning system along the Turnpike system throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Orange, Osceola, Sumter, and Hillsborough counties. Installation will occur along the Turnpike Extension/SR 821, Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91, Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869, Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429, and Veterans Expressway/SR 589. The system will alert motorists in advance of queuing or stopped traffic on the mainline that is backing up from specific congested interchanges through the Turnpike system. Construction will continue through early 2025. Approximate cost: \$6.8 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 FROM LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramps at Southern Boulevard/SR 80 (Exit 97)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 27, and nightly through Thursday, October 31.

Detour information:

- Southern Boulevard/SR 80 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441 to Lake Worth Road/SR 802, and travel east on Lake Worth Road to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Southern Boulevard/SR 80 (Exit 97) will be directed to exit at Okeechobee Boulevard/SR 704 (Exit 99), travel west on Okeechobee Boulevard to Jog Road, and travel south on Jog Road to access Southern Boulevard.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramp ramps at PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 109)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 27, and nightly through Thursday, October 31.

Detour information:

- PGA Boulevard/SR 786 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to I-95, travel north on I-95 to exit at Indiantown Road/SR 706/Okeechobee (Exit 87B), and travel west on Indiantown Road to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- PGA Boulevard/SR 786 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to Military Trail/SR 809, travel south on Military Trail to Northlake Boulevard, travel west on Northlake Boulevard to Jog Road, and travel south on Jog Road to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 109) will be directed to exit at Beeline Highway/SR 710 (Exit 107), travel north on Jog Road to Northlake Boulevard, travel east on Northlake Boulevard to Military Trail/SR 809, and travel north on Military Trail to access PGA Boulevard.
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 109) will be directed to exit at Indiantown Road/SR 706 (Exit 116), travel east on Indiantown Road to I-95, and travel south on I-95 to exit at PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 79).

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramps at Becker Road (Exit 138)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 27, and nightly through Thursday, October 31.

Detour information:

- Becker Road traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed west on Becker Road to I-95, travel north on I-95 to exit at Gatlin Boulevard (Exit 118), travel east on Gatlin

Boulevard to Port St. Lucie Boulevard, and travel east on Port St. Lucie Boulevard to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

- Becker Road traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to travel west on SW Becker Road to I-95, travel south on I-95, exit at SR 714/SW Martin County Highway (Exit 110), and travel east on SR 714/SW Martin County Highway to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Becker Road (Exit 138), will be directed to exit at SR 714/Stuart (Exit 133), travel west on SR 714/SW Martin County Highway to I-95, and travel north on I-95 to exit at Becker Road (Exit 114).
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Becker Road will be directed to exit at Port St. Lucie Boulevard (Exit 142), travel west on Port St. Lucie Boulevard to SW Gatlin Boulevard, travel west on SW Gatlin Boulevard to I-95, and travel south on I-95 to access Becker Road (Exit 114).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being converted to an Electronic Tolling Collection system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. This project includes the installation of new gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing mainline and existing toll plazas on the interchange ramps and addition of several new Dynamic Message Signs. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$107 million.
