



Palm Beach County Canal Improvements Project

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is conducting canal improvements along Florida's Turnpike Mainline/State Road (SR 91) from north of the L-38 Canal (milepost 79) to north of Atlantic Avenue/SR 806 (milepost 82) in Palm Beach County.

Benefits from this project include:

- Supporting future widening of Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91
- Improving safety by stabilizing canals to prevent erosion and protect infrastructure
- Enhancing ecosystems by restoring canal banks to boost habitat quality and water purity
- Increasing infrastructure resiliency by reconstructing canals for long-term durability

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust. The Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestions and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Work is anticipated to be completed by late 2026.

Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$30.8 million.

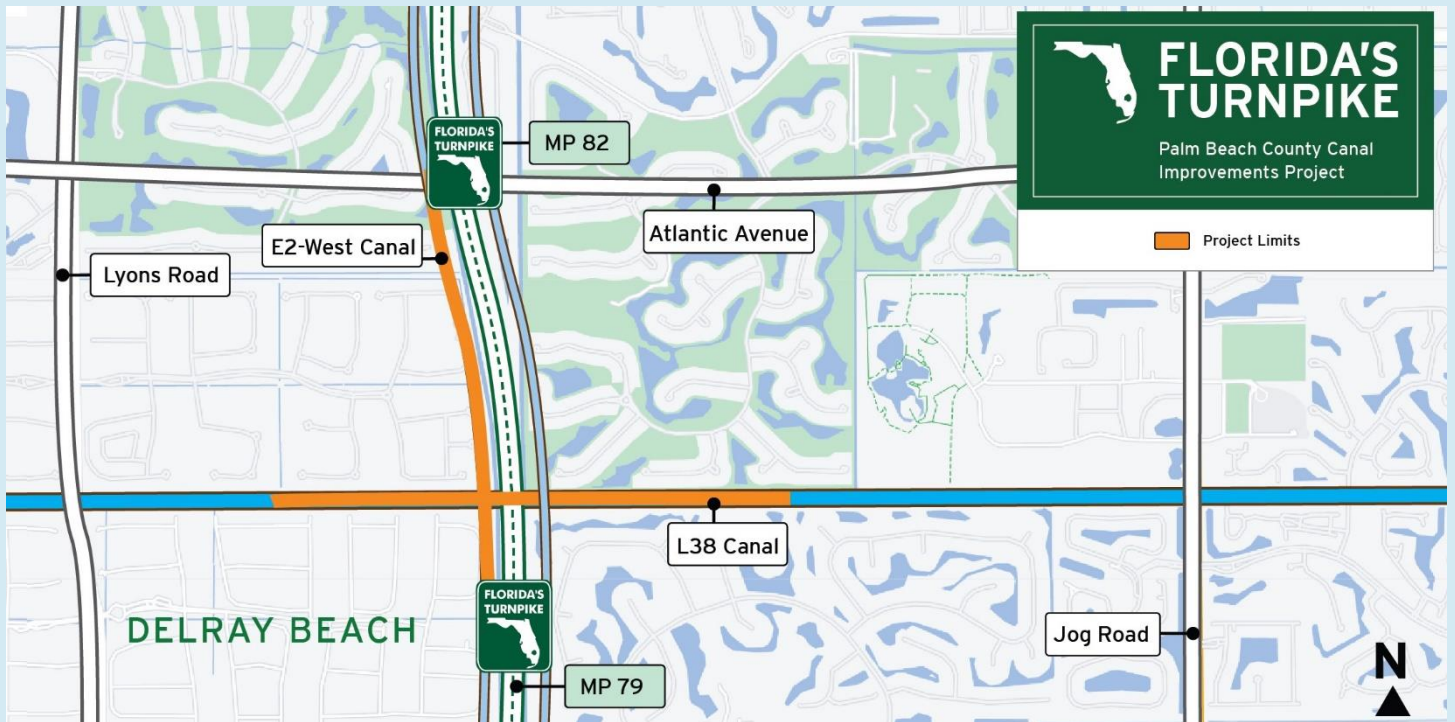
