

Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 Resurfacing and Roadside Improvements Project from SR 7/US 441 to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing and improving Sawgrass Expressway/State Road (SR) 869 from SR 7/US 441 to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91, in Broward County.

Benefits from this project include:

- Increasing roadway longevity and resiliency by repaving Sawgrass Expressway and existing ramps at SR 7, Lyons Road and Florida's Turnpike interchanges
- Improving roadside safety with the installation of new guardrail, rumble strips and highly reflective signing and pavement markings
- Adding two emergency vehicle crossover openings to the median of Sawgrass Expressway to facilitate emergency responder access

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust. The Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestions and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$21 million.
