South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory

FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla. — <u>Florida's Turnpike Enterprise</u> announces lane closures and work zone information for construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Okeechobee and Indian River counties, for the week beginning Sunday, November 10. Motorists should drive with caution through the work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.

Regularly scheduled construction and maintenance-related lane closures on Florida's Turnpike operated roads are suspended for the Veterans Day holiday from 6 a.m. Friday, November 8, to 10 p.m. Monday, November 11, unless otherwise indicated below.

Tandem truckers should also pay special attention to the closures noted in red which include full road and ramp closures and closures of special significance.

<u>TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 (Mileposts 0 to 47)</u> <u>MIAMI-DADE and BROWARD COUNTIES</u>

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NW 106 STREET TO INTERSTATE 75 (I-75)

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between NW 106 Street and I-75

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, November 10, and nightly through Thursday, November 14.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened to 10 lanes between NW 106 Street and I-75. The project entails constructing a new eastbound Okeechobee Road to southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp and a new northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to eastbound Okeechobee Road, as well as an additional lane in each direction on Okeechobee Road between west of the Turnpike and NW 107 Avenue. Work also consists of constructing a new diverging diamond interchange at Florida's Turnpike and NW 170 Street. Resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, lane striping, stormwater drainage, signage and lighting improvements will also be performed as part of this project. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$370 million.

GOLDEN GLADES INTERCHANGE (GGI) PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Miami Gardens Drive/NW 183 Street and I-95

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT & OPERATIONS PROJECT TO ADD AUXILIARY LANES FROM TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 TO GRIFFIN ROAD/SR 818

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Turnpike Extension/SR 821 (Milepost 47) and Griffin Road/SR 818 (Milepost 54)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, November 12, and nightly through Thursday, November 14.

Overnight multiple lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, November 12, and nightly through Thursday, November 14.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is adding auxiliary Lanes to the Mainline/SR 91 from the Turnpike Extension/SR 821 to Griffin Road/SR 818. This project will increase roadway capacity, reduce congestion and improve travel times. The project also includes safety improvements at Hollywood Boulevard/SR 820 and SW 63 Terrace by closing the median to reduce vehicle conflict points and accidents, and at Hollywood Boulevard and S. 62 Avenue by eliminating the eastbound and westbound turn lanes. Construction will continue through 2029. Approximate cost: \$230 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM POMPANO SERVICE PLAZA TO SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869

• Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Exit 21B) will be directed to exit at US 441/SR 7 South (Exit 18A), travel south on US 441 to Sample Road/SR 834, and travel east on Sample Road to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced and improvements are being made from the Pompano Beach Service Plaza to Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 (milepost 65 to milepost 71) in Broward County. A high friction surface treatment will be applied to the asphalt on the Mainline and existing ramps at the Atlantic Boulevard, Coconut Creek Parkway and Sample Road interchanges to reduce skidding. Improvements also include new highly reflective signing and pavement markings. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$16.2 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 AND ATLANTIC BOULEVARD INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 at Atlantic Boulevard

Overnight single and double lane closure, 10 p.m. Monday, November 11, to 6 a.m. Tuesday, November 12.

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, November 12, and nightly through Thursday, November 14.

Eastbound and westbound Atlantic Boulevard underneath Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, November 12, and nightly through Thursday, November 14.

Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Tuesday, November 12, and daily through Friday, November 15.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard (Exit 5) to north of Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8). The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. Work includes reconstructing the northbound and southbound entrance and exit ramps at Atlantic Boulevard, widening Atlantic Boulevard from two to three lanes and adding bike lanes, and stormwater management enhancements and modifications to the pond west of the roadway. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$72.5 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 WIDENING PROJECT FROM ATLANTIC BOULEVARD TO SAMPLE ROAD

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 between north of Atlantic Boulevard and north of Sample Road

Overnight single and double lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, November 12, and nightly through Thursday, November 14.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is widening Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 from six to 10 lanes from north of Atlantic Boulevard to north of Sample Road, in Broward County. The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. The Sample Road interchange will be converted to a partial diverging diamond interchange. Construction will continue through early 2028. Approximate cost: \$99.7 million.

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SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM US 441/SR 7 TO FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 between south of US 441/SR 7 and Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 BRIGE REHABILITATION PROJECT OVER HILLSBORO CANAL IN BROWARD COUNTY

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Milepost 73

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, November 12, and nightly through Thursday, November 14.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR91 is rehabilitating the bridge along Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 over the Hillsboro canal (milepost 73) in Broward County. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$6 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 CANAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM NORTH OF L-38 CANAL TO NORTH OF ATLANTIC AVENUE/SR 806

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Glades Road/SR 808 and Atlantic Avenue/SR 806 (Mileposts 79 to 82)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, November 12, and nightly through Thursday, November 14.

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PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR91 is conducting canal improvements along Florida's Turnpike Mainline/State Road (SR 91) from north of the L-38 Canal (milepost 79) to north of Atlantic Avenue/SR 806 (milepost 82) in Palm Beach County. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$30.8 million.

<u>CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 86 to 188)</u> PALM BEACH, MARTIN, ST. LUCIE, and OKEECHOBEE COUNTIES

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD TO NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 and north of Lake Worth Road/SR 802

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Monday, November 11, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, November 12. Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, November 12, and nightly through Thursday, November 14.

Eastbound and westbound Hypoluxo Road over Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 Extended single lane closures through early 2025. One lane will remain open in each direction.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened to four lanes in each direction, from north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Lake Worth Road/SR 802. This project also includes reconstructing the Hypoluxo Road bridge over Southern Turnpike Mainline to allow for the new road configuration. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and signal improvements are planned. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$170 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM MILEPOST 169 TO MILEPOST 178

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Milepost 169 and Milepost 178

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Monday, November 11, to 7 a.m. Tuesday, November 12. Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Tuesday, November 12, and nightly through Thursday, November 14.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing and making roadside improvements to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from milepost 169 to milepost 178, in St. Lucie and Indian River counties. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$25 million.

<u>FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE SYSTEM STATEWIDE</u> <u>MIAMI-DADE, BROWARD, PALM BEACH, MARTIN, ST. LUCIE, OKEECHOBEE</u> <u>and INDIAN RIVER COUNTIES</u>

SOUTH AND CENTRAL FLORIDA BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91, one mile south of Port St. Lucie Boulevard/SR 716 (Milepost 142)

Overnight intermittent single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, November 12, and nightly through Thursday, November 14.

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PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is rehabilitating multiple bridges along Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 throughout South and Central Florida. This project will reinforce and protect existing concrete piles, prolonging the life of the Turnpike bridges at milepost 142 in St. Lucie County, milepost 184 in Okeechobee County, and milepost 192 in Osceola County. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$5 million.

SYSTEM-WIDE QUEUE WARNING SYSTEM ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is enhancing the queue warning system along the Turnpike system throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Orange, Osceola, Sumter, and Hillsborough counties. Installation will occur along the Turnpike Extension/SR 821, Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91, Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869, Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429, and Veterans Expressway/SR 589. The system will alert motorists in advance of queueing or stopped traffic on the mainline that is backing up from specific congested interchanges through the Turnpike system. Construction will continue through early 2025. Approximate cost: \$6.8 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 FROM LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramps at Southern Boulevard/SR 80 (Exit 97)

Overnight full ramp closure, 10 p.m. Monday, November 11, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, November 12. Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, November 12, and nightly through Thursday, November 14.

- PGA Boulevard/SR 786 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to Military Trail/SR 809, travel south on Military Trail to Northlake Boulevard, travel west on Northlake Boulevard to Jog Road, and travel south on Jog Road to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

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- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 109) will be directed to exit at Beeline Highway/SR 710 (Exit 107), travel north on Jog Road to Northlake Boulevard, travel east on Northlake Boulevard to Military Trail/SR 809, and travel north on Military Trail to access PGA Boulevard.
