



Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 & Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 Interchange Improvements Project

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is improving the existing interchange at Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 and Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Exit 86), in Palm Beach County.

Benefits of this project include:

- Reducing congestion by constructing a turn lane from westbound Boynton Beach Boulevard to the northbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp
- Improving mobility by adding a second lane to the northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to Boynton Beach Boulevard
- Increasing roadside safety and improving visibility by installing new, highly reflective overhead signage and pavement markings for all lighting and weather conditions

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust throughout the project's duration. Florida's Turnpike Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts, and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

The project cost is approximately \$9.5 million.

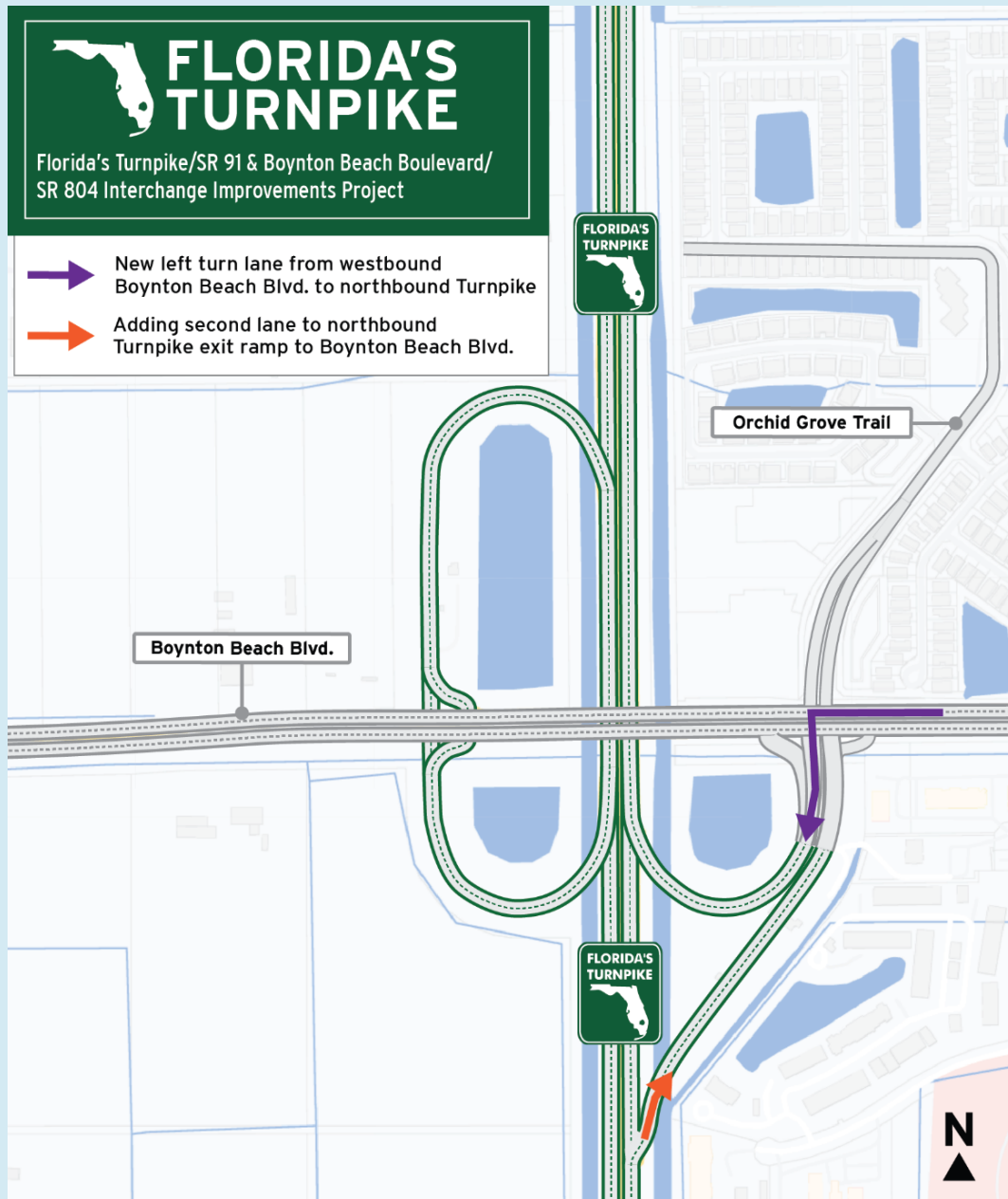
