Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory

OCOEE, Fla. – <u>Florida's Turnpike Enterprise</u> announces lane closures and work zone information for construction and maintenance projects in Central Florida beginning Sunday, January 5. Motorists should drive with caution through work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.

Tandem truckers should also pay special attention to the closures noted in red which include full road and ramp closures and closures of special significance.

<u>CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 188 to 240)</u> <u>OSCEOLA COUNTY</u>

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 FROM LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being converted to an Electronic Tolling Collection system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. This project includes the installation of new gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing mainline and existing toll plazas on the interchange ramps and addition of several new Dynamic Message Signs. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$107 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM CLAY WHALEY ROAD TO US 192 AND W. NOLTE ROAD INTERCHANGE

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from two to four lanes in each direction, from Clay Whaley Road (formerly Kissimmee Park Road) to US 192 in Osceola County. This project includes constructing a new interchange at W. Nolte Road and removing the existing ramps at Clay Whaley Road once the new interchange is open to traffic. Construction will continue through late 2028. Approximate cost: \$193 million.

<u>NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 240 to 309)</u> OSCEOLA, ORANGE, SEMINOLE, LAKE, and SUMTER COUNTIES

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM CANOE CREEK SERVICE PLAZA TO THREE LAKES TOLL GANTRY

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced between Canoe Creek Service Plaza and Three Lakes Toll Gantry (mileposts 227 to 235), in Osceola County. This project also includes installing high friction surface treatment to the asphalt to reduce skidding and improve vehicle traction during adverse weather conditions. New signage, pavement markings, new guardrails and lighting will be installed throughout the project limits. Construction will continue through late 2024. Approximate cost: \$16.9 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 AND SAND LAKE ROAD/SR 482 INTERCHANGE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Northbound and Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Beachline Expressway/SR 528 and Interstate 4 (Milepost 255 to Milepost 258)

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday January 6, and daily through Thursday, January 9.

Eastbound and westbound Sand Lake Road/SR 482 between John Young Parkway/SR 423 and Chancellor Drive

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, January 6, and daily through Friday, January 9.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A new interchange will be constructed at Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Sand Lake Road/SR 482 in Orange County. The project includes enhancing connectivity by constructing a new interchange at Sand Lake Road, increasing roadway longevity and resiliency with the reconstruction of the Sand Lake Road bridge to accommodate new ramps, improving traffic flow by enhancing the intersection of Presidents Drive and Sand Lake Road and providing sidewalks from John Young Parkway to Presidents Drive. Construction will continue through late 2027. Approximate cost: \$114.6 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM CLERMONT/SR 50 TO MINNEOLA/HANCOCK ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Clermont/SR 50 and Minneola/ Hancock Road

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 5, to 5 a.m. Monday, January 6. Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Wednesday, January 8.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Minneola/Hancock Road (Exit 278) and Clermont/SR 50 (Exit 272)

Overnight full road closure, 10:30 p.m. Thursday, January 9, to 5 a.m. Friday, January 10. **Detour information:**

• Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to exit at Minneola/Hancock Road (Exit 278), travel south on N. Hancock Road to W. Colonial Drive/SR 50, and travel east on W. Colonial Drive to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from N. Hancock Road

Overnight full ramp closure, 9 p.m. Thursday, January 9, to 5 a.m. Friday, January 10. **Detour information:**

 N. Hancock Road traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to W. Colonial Drive/SR 50, and travel east on W. Colonial Drive to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Clermont/SR 50 (Exit 272)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 5, to 5 a.m. Monday, January 6. Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Wednesday, January 8.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from W. Colonial Drive/SR 50

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 5, to 5 a.m. Monday, January 6. Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Wednesday, January 8.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from four to eight lanes from Clermont/SR 50 to Minneola/Hancock Road in Lake and Orange counties. This project includes constructing a new Fosgate Road bridge over the Turnpike. The CR 438 and CR 455 bridges will be replaced, as well as the Turnpike bridges over Jones Road, Old Highway 50, and Blackstill Lake Road. The West Orange Trail bridge over the Turnpike will be replaced with a prefabricated structure. New electronic tolling gantries will be installed, and the existing toll booths and canopies at the SR 50 entrance and exit ramps will be demolished. Safety improvements for this project include a new Intelligent Transportation system, signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting, and drainage. Construction will continue through mid-2026. Approximate cost: \$162.3 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM MINNEOLA/HANCOCK ROAD TO O'BRIEN ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Minneola/Hancock Road and north of O'Brien Road

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 5, to 5 a.m. Monday, January 6. Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

Intermittent daytime shoulder closures, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, January 6, and daily through Friday, January 10.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from four to eight lanes from Minneola to O'Brien Road in Lake County. This project includes replacing the bridges at Scrub Jay Lane, CR 561, US 19, and US 27/SR 19 South. New electronic tolling gantries and buildings will be installed, as well as new stormwater treatment facilities. Safety improvements for

this project include new signage, pavement markings, signalization, and lighting. Construction will continue through late 2028. Approximate cost: \$233 million.

SEMINOLE EXPRESSWAY/SR 417 WIDENING PROJECT FROM ALOMA AVENUE/SR 426 TO SR 434

Northbound and southbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 between south of SR 426 (Exit 38) and north of SR 434 (Exit 44)

Overnight single lane and shoulder closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 5, to 6 a.m. Monday, January 6. Overnight single lane and shoulder closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

Daytime shoulder closures, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, January 6, and daily through Friday, January 10.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Seminole Expressway/SR 417 is being widened from four to eight lanes between Aloma Avenue/SR 426 and north of SR 434 in Seminole County. This project includes the addition of two lanes in each direction of Seminole Expressway and replacing five bridges and widening and enhancing 12 existing bridges. Work also consists of underdeck lighting in all bridge spans, crossing roadways and pedestrian facilities and replacing signage and pavement markings. Construction will continue through late 2030. Approximate cost: \$300 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 AT DANIEL WEBSTER WESTERN BELTWAY/SR 429 BRIDGE PAINTING PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429 between Florida's Turnpike/SR 91/SR 429 (Exit 22) and West Colonial Drive/SR 50 (Exit 23)

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to southbound Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429 (Exit 267A)

Overnight intermittent single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to northbound Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429 (Exit 267A)

Overnight intermittent single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Five bridges at the Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429 interchange are being repainted in Orange County. The life of these bridges will be prolonged by cleaning/repainting the steel components and concrete surfaces to prevent corrosion and reduce water infiltration. This project includes improving the overall aesthetics of the structures, ensuring quality and longevity. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$4.7 million.

VETERANS EXPRESSWAY/SUNCOAST PARKWAY & POLK PARKWAY HILLSBOROUGH, PASCO, HERNANDO, CITRUS and POLK COUNTIES

VETERANS EXPRESSWAY SPUR/SR 568 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM VETERANS EXPRESSWAY/SR 589 TO DALE MABRY HIGHWAY/SR 597

Eastbound and westbound Veterans Expressway SPUR/SR 568 between Veterans Expressway/ SR 589 and Dale Mabry Highway/SR 597

Overnight single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Friday January 10.

Daytime single lane closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, January 6, and daily through Saturday, January 11.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Veterans Expressway Spur/SR 568 is being improved from Veterans Expressway/SR 589 to Dale Mabry Highway/SR 597 in Hillsborough County. Work includes installing high friction surface treatment to the asphalt which will improve safety, roadway softness and traction for drivers and the installation of new guardrail and pavement markings to improve visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. Construction will continue through 2024. Approximate cost: \$11.3 million.

SUNCOAST PARKWAY/SR 589 EXPANSION PROJECT FROM SR 44 TO W. NORVELL BRYANT HIGHWAY/CR 486

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 is being extended three miles northward from SR 44 to W. Norvell Bryant Highway/CR 486 in Citrus County. This extension is a new, four-lane (two lanes in each direction) tolled roadway. Construction will continue through 2026. Approximate cost: \$103 million.

VETERANS EXPRESSWAY/SR 589 DMS UPGRADE AND RETROFIT PROJECT

Northbound Veterans Expressway/SR 589 between Hillsborough Avenue (Exit 4) and Waters Avenue/SR 584 (Exit 6A)

Overnight full road closure, 9:30 p.m. Wednesday, January 8, to 5 a.m., Thursday, January 9. If necessary, thru lane closure may also occur from 9:30 p.m. Thursday, January 9, to 5 a.m. Friday, January 10.

Detour information:

- Northbound Veterans Expressway/SR 589 traffic wishing to continue north will be directed to exit at W. Hillsborough Avenue/SR 580 (Exit 4), travel east on W. Hillsborough Avenue to Hoover Boulevard, travel north on Hoover Boulevard to W. Waters Avenue/SR 584, and travel west on W. Waters Avenue to access northbound Veterans Expressway.
- W. Hillsborough Avenue traffic wishing to access northbound Veterans Expressway/SR 589 will be directed to Hoover Boulevard, travel north on Hoover Boulevard to W. Waters Avenue/SR 584, and travel west on W. Waters Avenue to access northbound Veterans Expressway.

Southbound Veterans Expressway/SR 589 between Waters Avenue/SR 584 (Exit 6A) and Hillsborough Avenue (Exit 4)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday January 5, to 7 a.m. Monday, January 6.

If necessary, this closure may also occur from 9 p.m. Monday, January 6, to 7 a.m. Tuesday, January 7.

Southbound Veterans Expressway/SR 589 between Waters Avenue/SR 584 (Exit 6A) and Memorial Highway/CR 576 (Exit 3)

Overnight full road closure, 9 p.m. Tuesday, January 7, to 5 a.m., Wednesday, January 8. If necessary, this closure may also occur from 9 p.m. Wednesday, January 8, to 5 a.m. Thursday, January 9.

Detour information:

- Southbound Veterans Expressway/SR 589 traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to exit at Waters Avenue/SR 584 (Exit 6A), travel east on W. Waters Avenue to Hoover Boulevard, travel south on Hoover Boulevard to W. Hillsborough Avenue/SR 580, and travel west on W. Hillsborough Avenue to access southbound Veterans Expressway.
- Anderson Avenue traffic wishing to access southbound Veterans Expressway/SR 580 will be directed to Hoover Boulevard, travel south on Hoover Boulevard to W. Hillsborough Avenue/SR 580, and travel west on W. Hillsborough Avenue to access southbound Veterans Expressway.

Southbound Veterans Expressway/SR 589 between Gunn Highway/CR 587 (Exit 9) and Linebaugh Avenue/Wilsky Boulevard (Exit 8)

Overnight full road closure, 9 p.m. Monday, January 6, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, January 7. **Detour information:**

- Southbound Veterans Expressway/SR 589 traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to exit at Gunn Highway/CR 587, travel west on Gunn Highway to Sheldon Road, travel south on Sheldon Road/CR 589 to Linebaugh Avenue, and travel east on Linebaugh Avenue to access southbound Veterans Expressway.
- Gunn Highway/CR 587 traffic wishing to access southbound Veterans Expressway/SR 589 will be directed to Sheldon Road, travel south on Sheldon Road/CR 589 to W. Linebaugh Avenue, and travel east on W. Linebaugh Avenue to access southbound Veterans Expressway.

Southbound Veterans Expressway/SR 589 between Linebaugh Avenue/Wilsky Boulevard (Exit 8) and Memorial Highway/SR 576 (Exit 3)

Overnight full thru lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday January 5, to 7 a.m. Monday, January 6. **Detour information:**

• Southbound thru lane traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to the general use lanes.

Southbound Veterans Expressway/SR 589 at Wilsky Boulevard

Overnight full thru lane closures, 9 p.m. Monday, January 6, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, January 7; and 9 p.m. Tuesday, January 7, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, January 8.

Detour information:

• Southbound thru lane traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to the general use lanes.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The dynamic message signs along Veteran's Expressway are being enhanced in Hillsborough County. This project includes removing and replacing overhead message boards, known as Dynamic Message Signs. Work also consists of installing up-to-date programming for the system that provides motorists with real-time safety messaging and roadway alerts. Construction will continue through early 2025. Approximate cost: \$1.8 million.

VETERANS EXPRESSWAY/SR 589 EMERGENCY STOPPING SITES PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: New emergency stopping sites on Veterans Expressway/SR 589 are being constructed between milepost 3 and milepost 12 in Hillsborough County. Work includes widening or resurfacing existing pavement, minor drainage improvements, lighting, signing, and pavement markings. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$4.8 million.

POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION PROJECT FROM INTERSTATE 4 (I-4) TO OLD DIXIE HIGHWAY

Eastbound and westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 between S. Florida Avenue (Exit 7) and Lakeland Highlands Road (Exit 9)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 5, to 6 a.m. Monday, January 6. Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: An 18-mile portion of Polk Parkway/SR 570 is being converted to electronic toll collection between I-4 and Old Dixie Highway/CR 546 in Polk County. This project includes constructing three new toll gantries at the Western Mainline (milepost 8), Central Mainline (milepost 13), and SR 540 New Mainline (milepost 15.5), replacing cash toll collections with electronic toll collection points and demolishing the existing Western and Central Mainline toll plazas. Construction will continue through early 2025. Approximate cost: \$31.6 million.

CENTRAL POLK PARKWAY/SR 570B PROJECT FROM POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 TO US 17/SR 35

Westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 between Lakeland/Auburndale/US 92 (Exit 17) and one mile west of Winter Lake Road (Milepost 13)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Wednesday, January 8.

Westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 exit ramp to Winter Lake Road/SR 540 (Exit 14)

Long-term full ramp closure through late 2025.

Detour information:

 Westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 traffic wishing to access Winter Lake Road/SR 540 (Exit 14) will be directed to exit at US 92 (Exit 17), travel east on US 92 to Recker Highway/CR 655, travel southeast on Recker Highway to Spirit Lake Road, and travel south on Spirit Lake Road to access Winter Lake Road.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Central Polk Parkway/SR 570B, a new, four-lane (two lanes in each direction), tolled roadway is being constructed in Polk County. This new stretch of roadway will begin at Polk Parkway/SR 570 and Winter Lake Road/SR 540 and extend approximately 6.5 miles to US 17/SR 35. Construction will continue through 2029. Approximate cost: \$257 million.

<u>FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE SYSTEM STATEWIDE</u> <u>OSCEOLA, ORANGE, SEMINOLE, LAKE, SUMTER, HILLSBOROUGH, PASCO, HERNANDO,</u> <u>CITRUS, POLK, DUVAL, and OKALOOSA COUNTIES</u>

SYSTEM-WIDE QUEUE WARNING SYSTEM ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The queue warning system is being enhanced along the Turnpike system throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Orange, Osceola, Sumter, and Hillsborough counties. Installation will occur along the Turnpike Extension/SR 821, Florida's Turnpike/SR 91, Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869, Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429, and Veterans Expressway/SR 589. The system will alert motorists in advance of queueing or stopped traffic on the mainline that is backing up from specific congested interchanges through the Turnpike system. Construction will continue through early 2025. Approximate cost: \$6.8 million.

CENTRAL FLORIDA WRONG-WAY DETECTION TECHNOLOGY IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Wrong-Way Vehicle Detection Systems (WWVDS) are being enhanced throughout Hillsborough, Pasco, Hernando, Polk, Orange, and Brevard counties by increasing the amount of wrong-way signage, roadway reflectors and pavement markings in locations along Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91, Beachline Expressway/SR 528, Polk Parkway/SR 589, and Veterans Expressway/Suncoast Parkway/SR 589. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$11 million.
