FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla. — <u>Florida's Turnpike Enterprise</u> announces lane closures and work zone information for construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Okeechobee and Indian River counties, for the week beginning Sunday, January 5. Motorists should drive with caution through the work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.

Tandem truckers should also pay special attention to the closures noted in red which include full road and ramp closures and closures of special significance.

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 (Mileposts 0 to 47) MIAMI-DADE and BROWARD COUNTIES

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NW 106 STREET TO INTERSTATE 75 (I-75)

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened to 10 lanes between NW 106 Street and I-75. The project entails constructing a new eastbound Okeechobee Road to southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp and a new northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to eastbound Okeechobee Road, as well as an additional lane in each direction on Okeechobee Road between west of the Turnpike and NW 107 Avenue. Work also consists of constructing a new diverging diamond interchange at Florida's Turnpike and NW 170 Street. Resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, lane striping, stormwater drainage, signage and lighting improvements will also be performed as part of this project. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$370 million.

SOUTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 0X to 86) and SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 MIAMI-DADE, BROWARD, and PALM BEACH COUNTIES

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 TSM&O PROJECT FROM TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 TO GRIFFIN ROAD/SR 818

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Turnpike Extension/SR 821 (Milepost 47) and Griffin Road/SR 818 (Milepost 54)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 5, to 6 a.m. Monday, January 6. Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Turnpike Extension/SR 821 (Milepost 47) and Griffin Road/SR 818 (Milepost 54)

Overnight multiple lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 5, to 5 a.m. Monday, January 6. Overnight multiple lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Auxiliary Lanes are being added to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from the Turnpike Extension/SR 821 to Griffin Road/SR 818. This project will increase roadway capacity, reduce congestion, and improve travel times. The project also includes safety improvements at Hollywood Boulevard/SR 820 and SW 63 Terrace by closing the median to reduce vehicle conflict points and accidents, and at Hollywood Boulevard and S. 62 Avenue by eliminating the eastbound and westbound turn lanes. Construction will continue through mid-2029. Approximate cost: \$230 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM POMPANO SERVICE PLAZA TO SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Coconut Creek Parkway and Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight multiple lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 5, to 6 a.m. Monday, January 6. Overnight multiple lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from Atlantic Boulevard/SR 814

Overnight full ramp closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 5, to 6 a.m. Monday, January 6. Overnight full ramp closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

Detour information:

 Atlantic Boulevard/SR 814 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441 to Commercial Boulevard/SR 870, and travel west on Commercial Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramps at Coconut Creek Parkway/Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard (Exit 67)

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramps at Sample Road/SR 834 (Exit 69)

Overnight full ramp closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 5, to 6 a.m. Monday, January 6. Overnight full ramp closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

Detour information:

- W. Sample Road/SR 834 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441 to Coconut Creek Parkway, and travel east on Coconut Creek Parkway to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

Turnpike/SR 91 (Exit 21B) will be directed to exit at US 441/SR 7 South (Exit 18A), travel south on
US 441 to Sample Road/SR 834, and travel east on Sample Road to access southbound Florida's
Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced and improvements are being made from the Pompano Beach Service Plaza to Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 (milepost 65 to milepost 71) in Broward County. A high friction surface treatment will be applied to the asphalt on the Mainline and existing ramps at the Atlantic Boulevard, Coconut Creek Parkway and Sample Road interchanges to reduce skidding. Improvements also include new highly reflective signing and pavement markings. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$16.2 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 AND ATLANTIC BOULEVARD INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 at Atlantic Boulevard

Overnight single and double lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 5, to 6 a.m. Monday, January 6.

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

Eastbound and westbound Atlantic Boulevard underneath Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 5, to 6 a.m. Monday, January 6. Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, January 6, and daily through Friday, January 10.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard (Exit 5) to north of Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8). The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. Work includes reconstructing the northbound and southbound entrance and exit ramps at Atlantic Boulevard, widening Atlantic Boulevard from two to three lanes and adding bike lanes, and stormwater management enhancements and modifications to the pond west of the roadway. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$72.5 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 WIDENING PROJECT FROM ATLANTIC BOULEVARD TO SAMPLE ROAD/SR 834

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 between north of Atlantic Boulevard and north of Sample Road/SR 834

Overnight single and double lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, January 7, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

<u>Eastbound and westbound Sample Road/SR 834 between Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 and</u> west of Sportsplex Drive

Daytime single and double lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, January 6, and daily through Thursday, January 9.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Atlantic Boulevard to north of Sample Road/SR 834, in Broward County. The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. The Sample Road interchange will be converted to a partial diverging diamond interchange. Construction will continue through early 2028. Approximate cost: \$99.7 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM US 441/SR 7 TO FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 between south of US 441/SR 7 and Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Overnight single and double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, January 5, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance ramps from Lyons Road Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, January 5, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

Northbound and southbound US 441/SR 7 between Winston Park Boulevard/Creekside Drive and NW 61 Street

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, January 5, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

Northbound and southbound Lyons Road between Winston Park Boulevard and Sawgrass Boulevard/Serko Boulevard

Daytime single lane closures, 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, January 6, and daily through Thursday, January 9.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being resurfaced from US 441/SR 7 to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91, in Broward County. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$21 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT OVER HILLSBORO CANAL IN BROWARD COUNTY

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Milepost 73

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 5, to 6:30 a.m. Monday, January 6. Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 bridges are being improved over the Hillsboro canal (milepost 73) in Broward County. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$6 million.

<u>CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 86 to 188)</u> PALM BEACH, MARTIN, ST. LUCIE, and OKEECHOBEE COUNTIES

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 AND BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD/SR 804 INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Exit 86) interchange is undergoing significant enhancements to improve traffic flow and safety. This project includes: a new westbound turn lane from Boynton Beach Boulevard to northbound Florida's Turnpike and an additional lane from the northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to Boynton Beach Boulevard. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new highly reflective overhead signage and pavement markings, designed for optimal visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. Construction is scheduled to continue through late 2025, with an approximate cost of \$9.5 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD TO NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Lake Worth Road/SR 802

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened to four lanes in each direction, from north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804. This project also includes reconstructing the Hypoluxo Road bridge over Southern Turnpike Mainline to allow for the new road configuration. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and signal improvements are planned. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$170 million.

WEST PALM BEACH SERVICE PLAZA PARKING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between south of Lake Worth Road/SR 802 and south of Southern Boulevard/SR 80 (Milepost 92 to Milepost 95)

Daytime shoulder closures, 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, January 6, and daily through Friday, January 10.

Overnight intermittent single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The truck parking facility at the West Palm Beach Service Plaza is being improved. Truck parking will be consolidated in the northern section of the service plaza to enhance traffic flow and increase the number of available truck spaces. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$32.4 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM WEST PALM BEACH SERVICE PLAZA TO NORTH OF SOUTHERN BOULEVARD

<u>Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Southern Boulevard/SR 80 and the</u> West Palm Beach Service Plaza

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from two to four lanes in each direction, from West Palm Beach Service Plaza to north of Southern Boulevard/SR 80 in Palm Beach County. This project includes reconstructing the Turnpike bridges over Forest Hill Boulevard/SR 882, Southern Boulevard/SR 80, and Belvedere Road. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new highly reflective overhead signage and pavement markings, designed for optimal visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. Construction will continue through early 2030. Approximate cost: \$258 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM MILEPOST 169 TO MILEPOST 178

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Milepost 169 and Milepost 178 Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 5, to 7 a.m. Monday, January 6.

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced and the roadside improved from milepost 169 to milepost 178, in St. Lucie and Indian River counties. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$25 million.

SW MARTIN HIGHWAY/SR 714 WIDENING PROJECT

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from Martin Highway/SR 714

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE SYSTEM STATEWIDE MIAMI-DADE, BROWARD, PALM BEACH, MARTIN, ST. LUCIE, OKEECHOBEE and INDIAN RIVER COUNTIES

SYSTEM-WIDE QUEUE WARNING SYSTEM ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The queue warning system is being enhanced along the Turnpike system throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Orange, Osceola, Sumter, and Hillsborough counties. Installation will occur along the Turnpike Extension/SR 821, Florida's Turnpike/SR 91, Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869, Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429, and Veterans Expressway/SR 589. The system will alert motorists in advance of queueing or stopped traffic on the mainline that is backing up from specific congested interchanges through the Turnpike system. Construction will continue through early 2025. Approximate cost: \$6.8 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 FROM LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance and exit ramps at Martin Highway/Stuart/SR 714 (Exit 133)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

Detour information:

- SW Martin County Highway/SR 714 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to I-95, travel north on I-95 to exit at Becker Road (Exit 114), and travel east on Becker Road to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 6, and nightly through Thursday, January 9.

 north on I-95 to exit at Gatlin Boulevard (Exit 118), travel east on Gatlin Boulevard to Port St. Lucie

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Port St. Lucie Boulevard (Exit 142) will be directed to exit at Okeechobee Road/SR 70/Ft Pierce (Exit 152), travel east on Okeechobee Road to I-95, travel south on I-95 to exit at SW Gatlin Boulevard (Exit 118), and travel east on SW Gatlin Boulevard to access Port St. Lucie Boulevard.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being converted to an Electronic Tolling Collection system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. This project includes the installation of new gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing mainline and existing toll plazas on the interchange ramps and addition of several new Dynamic Message Signs. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$107 million.
